**This past weekend was the start of something wonderful! This past weekend over 50 of your fellow parishioners and staff members met with an interviewer, Ms. Linda Banecker, from Catholic Leadership Institute.**

**They were asked to reflect on these questions and to share any other thoughts they had about our Parish moving forward into the future: What draws you to being part of this parish? In your role or ministry, what is the biggest leadership challenge you face? What is one problem, which if you solved it, would take the parish to a whole new level of effectiveness? When has the parish been at its best? Why does this experience stand out to you? This was the beginning of a four-year journey called: Next Generation Parish.**



**The Next Generation Parish Program is designed to help us assess and track our Parish's overall health using 4 Key Factors believing that a healthy parish is one that:**

- 2. Shares leadership and maintains a commitment to a healthy organization.**

**The Next Generation Parish Program is designed to help us envision our future, to help us strategically plan for that future with measurable benchmarks to assess our efforts and to help us, at the end of four years, to evaluate our strategic plan, re-envision and formulate the next plan.**

**Next month, all of you will be invited to become part of this plan by participating in an online survey that will add further information and data for our writing team. Then, driven by actual data, demographics and your input, we will commit to a three-year strategic plan for our Parish and her ministries. Indeed, this is wonderful – to have a road map, unique to our reality, to guide us into the next generation of faithful Catholic life! Pray for us!**

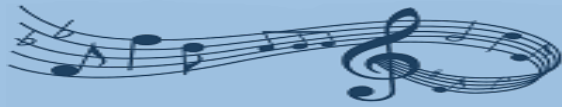

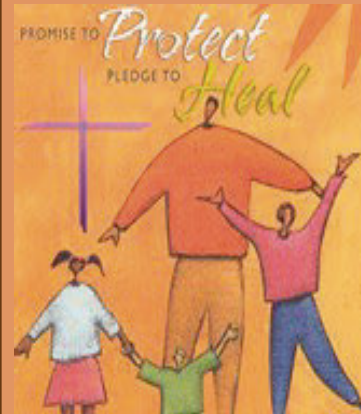
