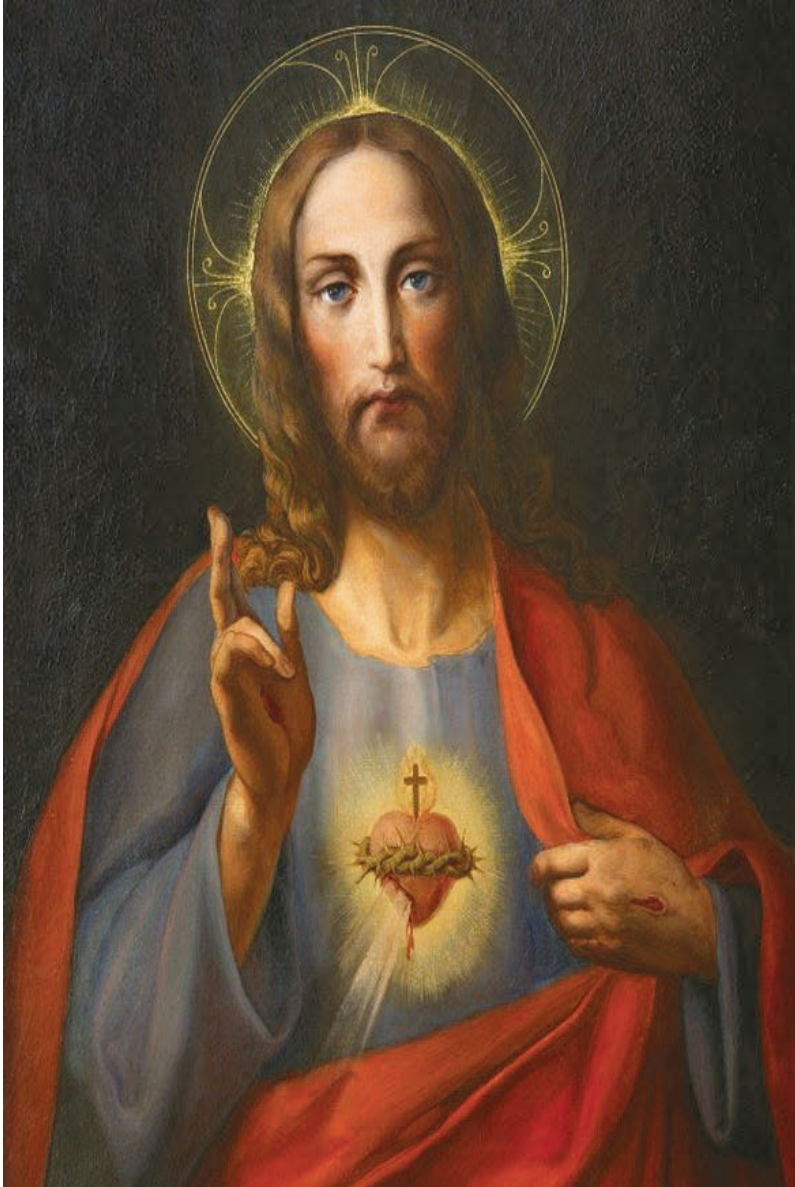

Dear friends in Christ,

When you have the opportunity to “get even”, what do you do? I’m not talking about Bengals fans here, I’m talking about the Bible readings for this Sunday!

In our first reading, David had the chance to kill Saul, who by everyone’s description and understanding, was out to kill him! But he did not. He chose to “honor God’s anointed one”. It would lead to repentance on Saul’s part and reconciliation between the two of them.



St. Paul uses a specific Greek word in the second reading today ‘sarx’ - “un-redeemed flesh” that we should note. It is that “earthly or fleshly” man, before God’s grace in Jesus Christ. It is us when we choose to act “in sin” and “outside of grace”.

And Jesus in the Gospel sets a higher standard for his followers; we must live by grace. It is not acceptable for us to “do the wrong that others do”, to “get even”. No, we are asked to forgive and love as God has forgiven and loved us; to measure out to others what God has poured into us. Indeed, be different, be redeemed, be holy, be disciples!

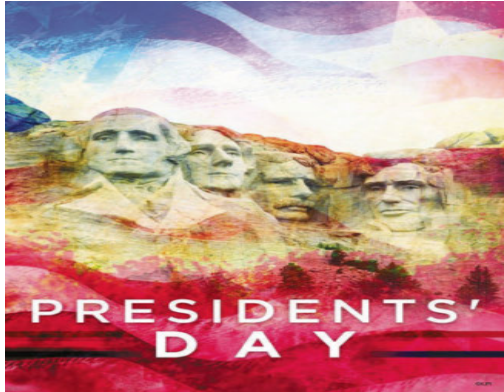

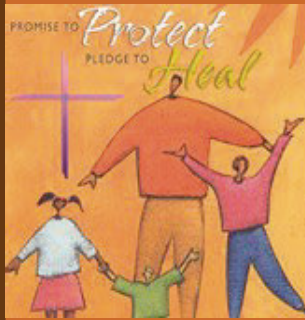

**or her safe and healthy. If someone tries to touch a child's private parts, the child should say "No!", run away, and tell a trusted adult.
