## SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

---

Dear followers of the Crucified,

In the first reading today what we experience is a “covenant ritual” that was common during the time of Abram. It was essentially based on fear. The parties entering into the covenant express their willingness to be “split in half” and sacrificed if they broke the agreement. No wonder Abram was “enveloped in a deep and terrifying darkness”. To follow God was literally a matter of life and death!



In Jesus Christ, God has made a covenant with us and it is also a matter of life and death! But we need not fear, for the sacrifice for our sin, for our disobedience, our breaking the covenant has already been offered. It is Jesus’ sacrifice on Calvary. We stand in hope of the covenant’s promise of eternal life, because God’s own Son paid the price for our sin.

Does that sacrifice make any difference to you? How do you show that in your life, your day-to-day life? Our hearts must always be filled with gratitude for what God has done. Our actions must be done in the most unselfish way, they must be done in imitation of Jesus’ love.

As we fast to discipline our passions, as we pray to draw closer to our God and Father, as we give alms to assist the poor and needy; let us remember the covenant. Let us remember Jesus.

I hope that each of our families will make Together in Mission part of their alms-giving. The envelopes are in the pews, please take one and help our Catholic brothers and sisters here in our own Archdiocese. You may also log on or use the QR code in this bulletin. Please help.

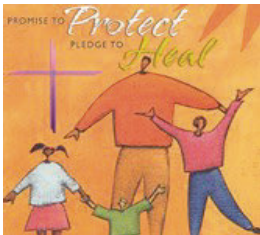

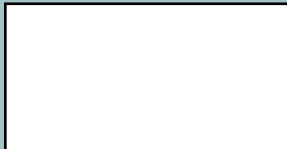

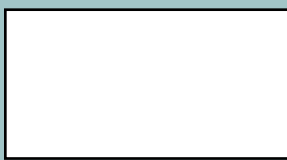
