THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

Dear followers of the Crucified,

Do you know that you are always standing on holy ground, fed with holy food and on the journey with the holy One of Israel? This is our privilege as baptized children of God!



In your prayer this week, look back and consider: “When was my ‘burning bush’ encounter with God?” “When did I first become aware that God was truly God”? I hope you can identify the time or times that it has happened; when you were ‘awe-struck’ by the reality of God. This is the foundation on which we all need to stand.

Second to this ‘pillar of faith’ is the recognition that we have been ‘fed by the hand of God’. Let your prayer move to thoughts of our complete dependence on God. Consider how God sustains you, feeds you, and makes you strong for the journey. One of the great definitions of the Eucharist is “bread for the journey”.

And lastly for your prayer this Third week of Lent, consider the fig tree. God is looking for the ‘good fruit’ of our discipleship. We are ‘to bear fruit’, by God’s grace and nourishment of our souls. Where are you, as a disciple, bearing fruit that will last? I suggest specifically the question: “where are you helping another to stand firm on the foundation of Jesus, God made flesh, our nourishment for the journey, our Savior and life for the world”?

Please continue to pray for our candidates for Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation, young and old. The holy season of Lent is a special time of grace for them. Our Adults will be anointed this weekend, as will our Year I Confirmation candidates.

This work of being a disciple and follower of the Crucified, this is our privilege as baptized children of God!

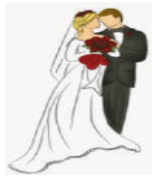

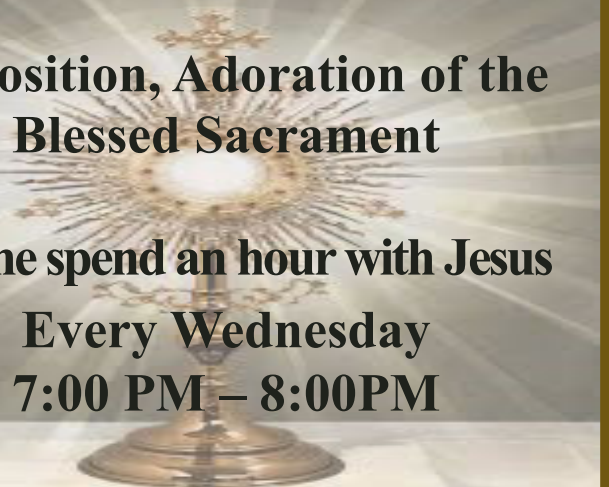

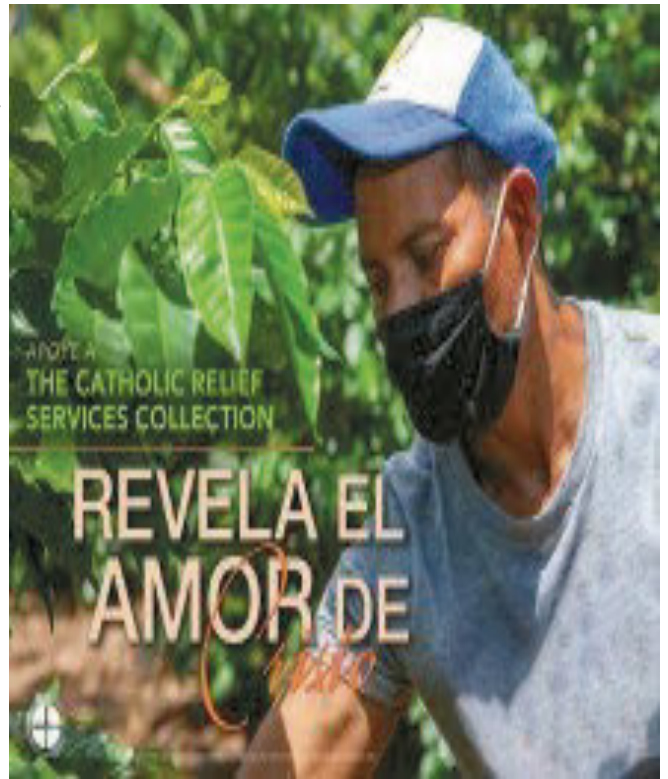

NEXT WEEK, OUR PARISH WILL TAKE UP THE CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES COLLECTION

The Catholic Relief Services Collection is an opportunity for you to help improve the lives of the most vulnerable people around the world and here in the United States. Your support funds organizations dedicated to aiding people affected by war and natural disasters, migrants and refugees in need of material and legal assistance, and people worldwide whose livelihoods are impacted by changing political and environmental conditions. Guatemala is a leading producer of coffee, growing more than three million 132-pound bags annually, much of it exported to the United States, Japan, and Canada. Aged farms, climate change, soil depletion, and a fungal infection called coffee leaf rust that causes leaves to fall off the plant and kill it— all of these pose challenges for small coffee farmers. Odilio Geronimo is one such farmer, whose ability to support his wife and young son was threatened by a fractured foot he suffered in an accident and by a crop destroyed by leaf rust. Catholic Relief Services (CRS) is helping Guatemalan coffee farmers like Odilio through a water-smart agriculture program that teaches farmers practices such as soil-quality identification, use of cover crops, and use of better compost.

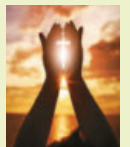

- Cookies



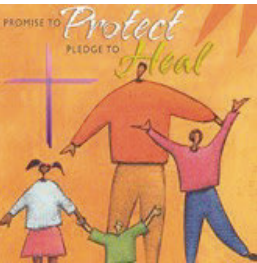
