PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD APRIL 10, 2022

Dear friends of Jesus Christ, our Messiah, Lord and Savior,

Happy Palm Sunday! (a.k.a Passion Sunday) We have made it to the great and beautiful celebrations of Holy Week! These are days of grace and emotion, of tragedy and triumph, of despair and hope, of death and life. These holy days are us willingly allowing ourselves to be transported to, and transformed by, the events that saved us. It is not "a play" or mere reenactment, no, in the Church's understanding it is, outside of time and space: real, here and now! In our world filled with emotion, tragedy, despair and death; how could we not fully participate in these days of grace, triumph, hope and life? Please make every effort to



be present at all of our Holy Week Prayer; you will be blessed beyond your greatest hopes or dreams!

It was a blessing and joy to have celebrated the gift of penance with so many of you at our Couples Penance Service, Teen Penance Service, Senior Citizen Penance Service and our General Parish Penance Service. How beautiful it is to be restored in our relationship with God and our brothers and sisters in the church, the body of Christ. The last opportunity for Confessions before Easter is this Tuesday, April 12th from 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM.

For those of you old enough to remember, we used to call this the "Easter duty". That is, at least once a year, preferably between Ash Wednesday and Pentecost Sunday to acknowledge our sins in the Sacrament of Confession and be reconciled to God and our brothers and sisters in Christ. The only sins that God cannot forgive are those we refuse to bring to the Sacrament! God's mercy and the Church's mercy are without limit; we will not give up on any repentant sinner! It is what God has shown us in Christ and what we must live out in our world. We are truly to be "ministers of God's reconciliation". And again, how wonderful it is that during the holy days of Holy Week God brings this grace, triumph, hope and life to our hearts!

This week is also the time to finalize your plans for Easter Mass. Two reminders: first, because there is no Saturday 4:00 PM Mass due to the Easter Vigil at 7:30 PM, we have added an Easter Evening Mass at 4:00 PM on Easter Sunday; secondly, don't forget to reach out to family and friends to invite them to attend with you! I hope we can make it possible for others to get here, experience the joy of a lived faith, celebrate a renewed hope and perhaps be more present to the Lord's saving mystery – the Mass.

Please pray for the Priests of our Archdiocese, who will renew their priestly vows on Monday at our Chrism Mass. At this Mass we will also bless the Holy Oils that will be distributed to all of the Parishes in our Archdiocese, a symbol of our unity, one church, under one shepherd. And that all of us exercise not our own ministry but the ministry of the shepherd Jesus Christ! I will be there, pray for me for I know what Jesus demands of me in service to you, his chosen ones.

Cursillo is a Spanish word meaning short course. A Cursillo therefore is a short course in Christianity. While Cursillo originated in Spain in the 1940s, today Cursillo Weekends are given in more than 50 nations on 5 continents.

To explain a Cursillo to someone who has never experienced it is difficult and somewhat mystifying. The reason behind the mystery is God. No one can fully explain how God touches each person in His special/unique way throughout the movement. For some, it is a total turnabout in their lives; for others, it is a gran awakening; for yet others, it is an enrichment of what they have already known and have been living. We do not promise anything or judge anyone- we simply offer the program and rely on the grace of God and the openness of the individual to produce its benefits.

The Cursillo is an opportunity to form and live in community with other Catholics and clergy members. It is immersed in Catholic Doctrine and the Sacraments, most importantly it is an encounter with Christ.

We are excited to announce the return of Cursillo weekends this spring at the Cursillo House in Pomona, Ca. The spring schedule is as follows.

Men's Weekend Women's' Weekend April 21-24, 2022 April 28- May 1st, 2022

These 72-hour Cursillo weekends begin on Thursday evenings with meditation and silence. Daily Mass will be celebrated. 




