# GOSPEL MEDITATION ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

In my parents' bedroom, there were on the wall two photos of my mom and dad from their early adulthoods. The photo of my mother entranced me when I was a boy. I loved looking at it, even though I saw her in daily life. Something about that picture captured her perfectly. It was an image of the joy, wisdom, beauty, and strength that enveloped me from the start of my life. It was an icon of the woman who fed, taught, and encouraged me. I felt a deep pride that I came from such beauty.

The beatitudes of Jesus are a kind of self-portrait. But it is a strange picture. At first, the blessings of being poor, mourning, and hungering and thirsting for righteousness may seem bizarre or, worse, a religious delusion. Who wants to look like that? But if we look again, we begin to see the characteristics of Jesus' form. He becomes poor and fills it with his riches for us, he weeps and mourns for us, and fills it with his joy, he hungers and thirsts for us to be righteous, and so satisfies us. And so on. It's the way he appears on the cross.

Perhaps we should put on our bedroom walls the words of the beatitudes next to a crucifix of the Lord Jesus. Then we can do what the beatitudes are designed for, to gaze at the joy, wisdom, beauty, and strength of the one who is our origin, and who is with us every day. And little by little, we'll start to look like him.

## **Anointing of the Sick**

Saturday, Feb. 11 at 3:30 pm Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes

Parishioners who would like to celebrate the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick are welcome to join us at 3:30 pm, and remain with us to celebrate our 4:00 pm Mass.

Who should be anointed? Those whose health, either in body, mind or spirit, is seriously impaired by sickness or old age should receive the Sacrament.

How many times can the Sacrament be received? The Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after being anointed and then again falls ill or if during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious. A sick person may be anointed before surgery. Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present.

May a child be anointed? Yes, sick children are to be anointed when facing serious illnesses.

Is the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick the same as "Last Rites"? No, this Sacrament is for the Sick. To understand this more clearly, one of the closing prayers states: "heal their sickness and forgive their sins; expel all afflictions of mind and body; mercifully restore them to full health, and enable them to resume their former duties, for you are Lord forever and ever."

Then, what are the Last Rites? When the Christian is approaching their reunion with God, that is they are actively dying, there are two moments the Church provides. The first, while they are conscience and responsive, they celebrate, Viaticum. In this prayer, the person has the opportunity for a final confession, the renewal of their Baptismal promises and receiving Holy Communion in a final act of uniting themselves to the life, death and resurrection present in the Eucharist.

After this, or if the person is not conscience or able to respond, the prayer proper to that moment is the Commendation of the Dying. In these prayers, we recall Scriptures that remind us of the power of God's love and the gift of salvation. We call upon Mary, the mother of Jesus and our mother, the angels and saints, and all of God's holy people, to pray for the person who is dying.

When the moment of death seems near, we commend the person to God with these words: "Go forth Christian soul, from this world in the name of God the almighty Father, who created you, in the name of Jesus Christ, Son of the living God, who suffered for you, in the name of the Holy Spirit, who was poured out upon you, go forth, faithful Christian. May you live in peace this day, may your home be with God in Zion, with Mary the virgin Mother of God, with Joseph and all the saints. Amen.

## RCIA

The RCIA process is designed for individuals who are not baptized, those baptized in other Christian faiths, and baptized Catholics who never received the Sacrament of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

- It is a faith journey that encourages individuals to broaden and deepen their prayer life; to know God through the scriptures; to come to know themselves more fully, and to actively participate in parish and community activities.
- Many individuals begin the process during late summer/early fall and are able to celebrate full sacramental initiation at the Easter Vigil (Holy Saturday Night) the following spring.
- Parish members are invited to become directly involved by sponsoring a candidate. We also encourage and invite all who may be interested, to come and see what living life as a committed Catholic Christian can mean to you.
