# Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

February 5, 2023



Dear Friends in Christ,

What a wonderful turnout we had for Catholic School's Week last Sunday! Thank you to all of our parishioners, parents and the whole school community for supporting the events this week, our Open House, and our Book Fair.

I pray for our students to "go beyond, knowing about Jesus, to knowing Jesus". Parents, please explain that line to your children. I pray that you parents will continue to develop your own relationship with Jesus and that you will faithfully worship with us at the Eucharist as Jesus commanded (too many of you are MIA from Sunday Mass). Lent is coming, redouble your efforts to get your children and yourselves to heaven.

I pray that parishioners will continue to support the ministry and services of our school and help us to build needed projects as part of our Called to Renew Campaign. I pray that many young people, in future generations, will be blessed by our efforts. Remember, Christianity is always, only one generation away from extinction! (Who knows, by these acts of love, these sacrifices you make, they could be the very things that will make God smile and invite you into heaven?).

Next Saturday, Feb. 11th, you, and those you bring, will have the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick at 3:30 pm, just before our 4:00 pm Mass. I say, "those you bring", because I would encourage you to reach out to the elders around you, family, friends, and neighbors, and help them get here! Pick them up, give them the extra time they may need, help them in and out of the car - do whatever it takes to make it possible for them. (Who knows, that single act of love, that sacrifice you make, could be the very thing that will make God smile and invite you into heaven? You might try to up your chances by taking them out to dinner afterwards).

The bible readings for this 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time begins with a challenge to care for the less fortunate: the hungry, the oppressed and the homeless. They continue with the Gospel challenging us to make a difference in the world, to be "salt and light". And all so that others may "see and glorify your Heavenly Father". Isn't it interesting that others believing in the fatherly love of God would depend on us being credible witnesses? Perhaps, because by being salt and light, we too are transformed and become more clearly what God created us to be. Thus, all the world is lifted up! Consider how the corporal works of mercy: feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, clothing the naked, sheltering the homeless, visiting the sick, visiting the imprisoned, and burying the dead are being witnessed to by your life. (Who knows, these acts of love, the sacrifices you make, could be the very things that will make God smile and invite you into heaven?).

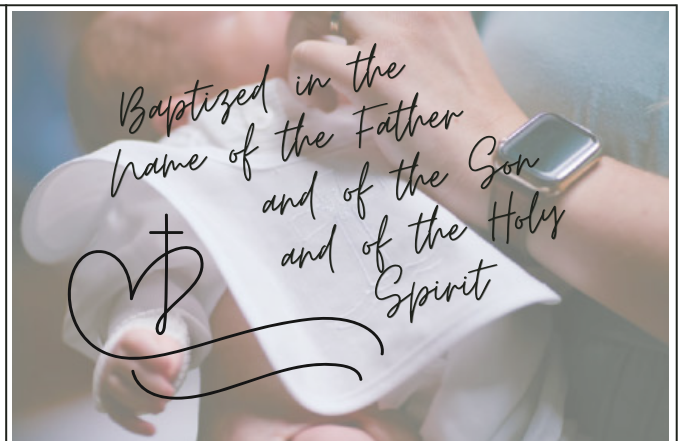

## RCIA

The RCIA process is designed for individuals who are not baptized, those baptized in other Christian faiths, and baptized Catholics who never received the Sacrament of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

- It is a faith journey that encourages individuals to broaden and deepen their prayer life; to know God through the scriptures; to come to know themselves more fully, and to actively participate in parish and community activities.
- Many individuals begin the process during late summer/early fall and are able to celebrate full sacramental initiation at the Easter Vigil (Holy Saturday Night) the following spring.
- Parish members are invited to become directly involved by sponsoring a candidate. We also encourage and invite all who may be interested, to come and see what living life as a committed Catholic Christian can mean to you.

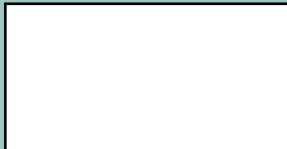

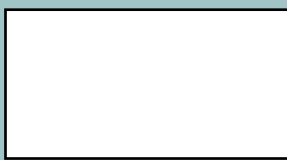
