## **Second Sunday of Lent**

March 5, 2023

Dear Brothers and Sisters of Our Crucified Lord,



The moment of the Transfiguration reveals two important teachings for those of us trying to follow Jesus. The first, remember the true nature and glory of who Jesus is. He is God. He is the fulfillment of all revelation. He is the fullness of God's teaching begun in Moses. He is the righteousness of God to be lived as proclaimed by the Prophets. The second is "rise and do not be afraid". Jesus also the friend of Peter, James and John. He is your friend and mine, like us in human form. And he has chosen to "be with us", Emmanuel. We do not need to be afraid.

My prayer, this second week of Lent, is that all of us may remember and experience Jesus as Lord and God. That we may be fully aware that He is with us, in all moments of our life's journey. And that we would not be afraid to answer His call to be holy, to trust, and to put all of our hope in Him. These forty days will only bear the fruit that God desires if we travel them with Jesus.

Thank you all for the prayers you offered for the repose of the soul of Bishop Dave O'Connell. I would encourage you all to visit the website: https://ahailmaryforbishopdave.com/funeral to read more about his life, to pray for him, to share with his family the good work that God accomplished through him and to commit to prayers and works of justice and mercy in his name. Even in this tragedy, God, who is present always and everywhere, is calling us to something good. It has already begun. Bishop Dave's family is also viewing this website and finding great consolation in their sadness. I ask you, as part of your Lenten sacrifice, to go to the website and see the great good God has begun and will continue through this one man, priest, bishop, and friend to all.

Also, during Lent, pray for those who are receiving any or all of the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Eucharist or Confirmation. As we pray for them we should reflect on the promises of Baptism and on the Creed. The three questions that precede the Creed are: "Do you reject Satan? And all his works? And all his empty promises? And the Creed of Lent and Easter is the Apostles Creed: "I believe in God the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell; the third day, He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God the Father almighty, from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen. I encourage you to answer these questions and to pray the Creed, every day of Lent. It will help you to remember who Jesus is and who you are.

A reminder of the beautiful devotion, the Stations of the Cross, which take place here every Friday night. It is our chance to walk with Jesus who walks with us. Please join us.

The Bethlehem Christian Families are here to sell their hand carved religious articles made of olive wood.


The sale of these precious articles supports their Church Mission which is to maintain the roots and the existence of the Christian Families who are struggling to remain in Bethlehem.

This partnership is part of a comprehensive abuse protection effort in the archdiocese that includes mandatory fingerprinting, background checks, and safe environment training.

The RCIA process is designed for individuals who are not baptized, those baptized in other Christian faiths, and baptized Catholics who never received the Sacrament of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.
