March 12, 2023

Archdiocese of Los Angeles
fingerprinting procedures

The Archdiocese provides fingerprinting services
free of charge and works with the California
Department of Justice to have these fingerprints
submitted and scanned by the appropriate
agencies. Anyone in the archdiocese who has
regular contact with minors or vulnerable adults,
whether in a paid or volunteer position, must be
fingerprinted before they can begin work.

#### RCIA

The RCIA process is designed for individuals who are not baptized, those baptized in other Christian faiths, and baptized Catholics who never received the Sacrament of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

It is a faith journey that encourages individuals to broaden and deepen their prayer life; to know God through the scriptures; to come to know themselves more fully, and to actively participate in parish and community activities.

Many individuals begin the process during late summer/early fall and are able to celebrate full sacramental initiation at the Easter Vigil (Holy Saturday Night) the following spring.

Parish members are invited to become directly involved by sponsoring a candidate. We also encourage and invite all who may be interested, to come and see what living life as a committed Catholic Christian can mean to you.
