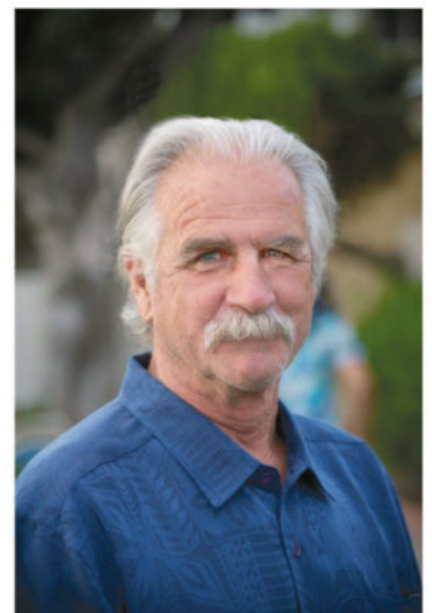

Please keep his wife Connie and all his family and friend in your prayers.

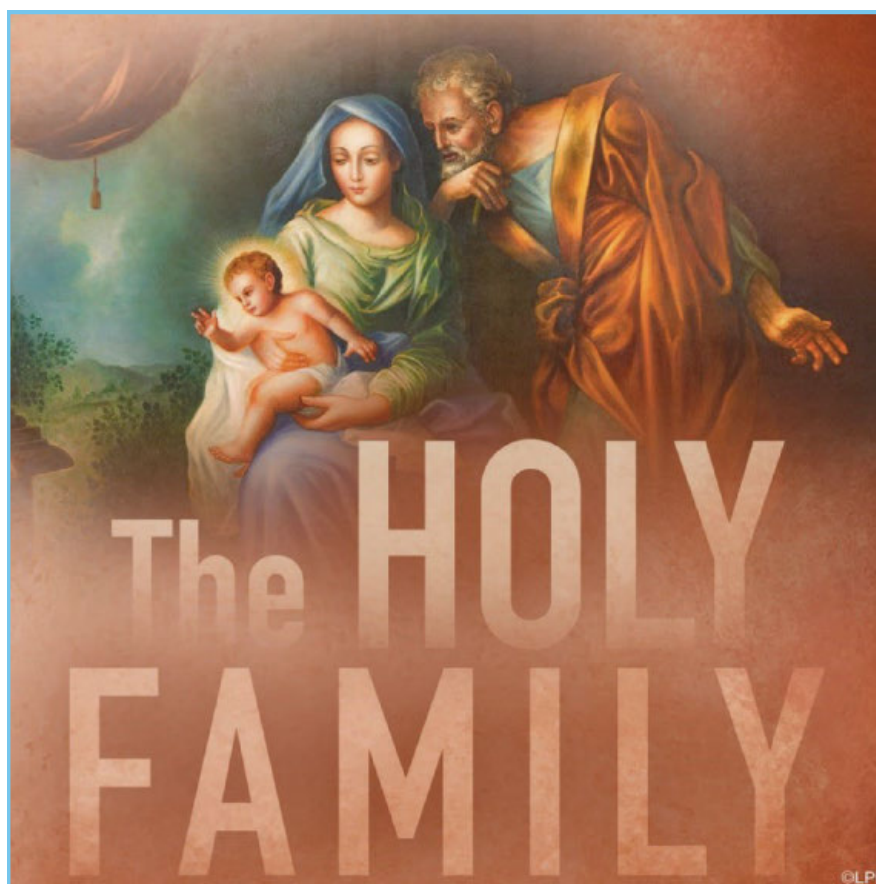


PASTOR'S PAGE

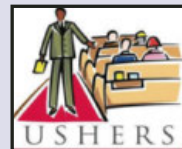
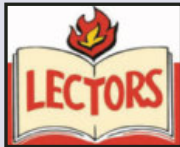
