Bread of Life

I heard of a woman named Shannon did her first Ironman triathlon a few years back. She'd been doing triathlons for more than a decade, but this was the first one anywhere near that long. It's a 2.4-mile swim, followed by a 112-mile bike, and then a 26.2-mile run. She raised more than \$20,000 in donations, so the pressure was on—she had to finish, which she did, in 10 hours, with a smile on her face.

People always ask triathletes why they do something that demands so much time and is so physically grueling. One answer from a triathlete is: It's exciting to do something really hard with a bunch of other people who are trying to do the same thing. And there are even more people on the sidelines cheering you on. It's an incredible feeling of camaraderie and community.

I learned that Shannon's friends gathered with her the night before for an Italian feast heavy with carbs—essential for triathletes before a race of this magnitude. The host, Jenny, made baskets full of sourdough bread. Jenny still makes bread from that same starter culture—it's sort of weird the way bread is alive like that—and they think of Shannon and her amazing race when they eat it.

The Real Presence

When in the Mass the priest pronounces the words of eucharistic consecration, "This is my body, this is my blood," the underlying reality of the bread and wine is changed into the body

and blood of Christ, given for us in sacrifice. Christ himself is really and substantially present, in a mysterious way, under the appearance of bread and wine.

Eucharist means "thanksgiving" because Christ gave thanks at the Last Supper before he broke the bread. It refers to the miraculous real presence of Christ in the bread and wine of the Mass, to the sacramental sacrifice of the Mass and to the communion of the faithful whereby Christ nourishes the soul. "For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." (Jn 6:55-56)

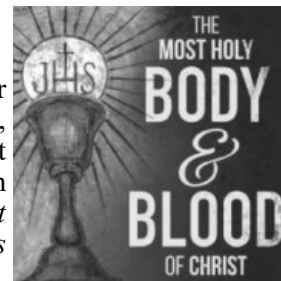

Back to Ordinary Time

After our full participation in the forty days of Lent, the Triduum, and the fifty days of Easter, we now return to counting or numbering the weeks, not the days, of the liturgical year. Ordinary Time, which will take us through the summer and fall, comprises the thirty or so weeks that are not marked by major feasts. The longest stretch or Ordinary Time begins after Evening Prayer on the Solemnity of Pentecost and continues up to the start of the new liturgical year on the First Sunday of Advent. The seasons of the Church reflect the rhythms of our lives, with peak moments and times of quiet growth. The liturgical color of Ordinary Time, green, reminds us that this is still a season of growth in our discipleship, a time to continue maturing into the followers of Jesus Christ we are meant to be.

Pan de vida**

Escuché de una mujer llamada Shannon que hizo su primer triatlón Ironman hace unos años. Ella había estado haciendo triatlones durante más de una década, pero este fue el primero en cualquier lugar cerca de ese tiempo. Es un nado de 2.4 millas, seguido de una bicicleta de 112 millas y luego una carrera de 26.2 millas. Es un sentimiento increíble de camaradería y comunidad.

Supe que los amigos de Shannon se reunieron con ella la noche anterior para un festín italiano repleto de carbohidratos, algo esencial para los triatletas antes de una carrera de esta magnitud. La anfitriona, Jenny, hizo canastas llenas de pan de masa fermentada. Jenny todavía hace pan a partir de esa misma cultura inicial, es un poco extraño que el pan esté vivo de esa manera, y cuando lo comen, piensan en Shannon y su increíble raza.

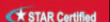
