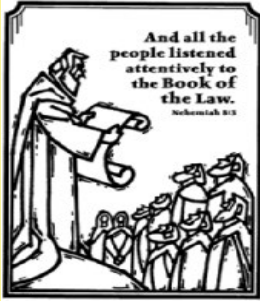

**Theme: The Spirit of the Lord has come to set us free.**

3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C, January 23, 2022

First Reading Neh 8:2-4a, 5-6, 8-10, Second Reading 1 Cor 12:12-30, Gospel Lk 1:1-4; 4:14-21

The first reading recalls the rebuilding of the people of Israelites after their return from exile. The events in today's first reading are the efforts of the priest Ezra to unify those returning from exile and restore the consciousness of the covenant with God, which had always been the foundation of Israel's life. At this time the rebuilding of the temple is delayed, the houses and properties of the returnees are still occupied by foreigners and the monarch is no longer in existence. The only thing still standing that can foster this unity is God's law transmitted through Moses. It is this law or God's commandments that Ezra the priest stands before the people to read publicly in the assembly of the people. For the first time after the exile, the Israelites gather as a people to celebrate the proclamation of the word of God and share in a festive meal. The proclamation of the word by Ezra the priest was to call the people to true repentance and good relationships with God and assure them of hope in God who has established this covenant with them.

The experience of Israel in this event is for us never to forget the word of God in our lives. Even when we think that we have lost everything in life due to life's challenges or circumstances, we should hold on to the sense of divine, the sense of God and the word of God we have received. The word of God is life and when we hold on to it, it gives meaning to our lives. Paul in the second reading talks about the unity of spirit we share as Christians. Paul calls us to realize that we are all one body in Christ Jesus and the gift each has is meant for the building of the church.

In the Gospel, Luke, who was not satisfied with other peoples' story about Jesus, decided to put down his own to let Theophilus know the certainty of the Message of Jesus Christ. One central message that comes to mind in Luke's opening gospel is to discover Jesus personally so that you can share it with conviction. We also see the idea of investigation and research being at play in this passage. Those who search with an open mind and heart into the word of God will always be given wisdom and inspiration by God. The word of God is Spirit and they are life.

Jesus starts His public ministry when He comes into the Synagogue and was given the scroll and opening it He reads from the Prophet Isaiah; Isaiah 61 the Spirit of the Lord is with me and sent me to bring good news to the poor, liberation to captives and to preach the year of harvest to the people. The people are well versed with this passage from their scroll, but there is a new turn of understanding as Jesus tells them that the fulfillment of the prophecy is with Him. It is for this purpose that He came to deliver those in all forms of bondage and the worst bondage is the bondage of evil which blinds one not to experience the light of Christ. May that same Spirit lighten our heart and set us free to be with the Lord.

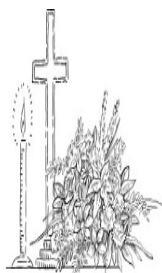

## **GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE**

January 23, 2022

3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time



Human history reveals many periods where people lost a sense of God’s transcendence. It may even be argued that human beings have been wandering and lost more than they have been at home and focused. Human nature being what it is, we struggle with who God really is — the God of our salvation history or the “gods” of human constructs. Relying on our own designs and pursuits, we forget that we really are meant to listen to One, upon whom the Spirit of the Lord rests, Jesus Christ, and not to ourselves. That same history that reveals our fickleness and infidelity also reveals God’s constancy and faithfulness. God always finds us.

As people wander and fumble to find their way, God is there bringing them back to holiness and giving them the assurance of His presence. We have to allow God’s Word, God’s life, to touch us and change us. It can make us more flexible and attentive to the sacred in all facets of life so that every day is one that is holy. Every day is a time when fulfillment is possible for one’s soul. Jesus stood before those gathered in the synagogue as the fulfillment of words of promise that were echoed long ago. God doesn’t forget. He always comes for us.

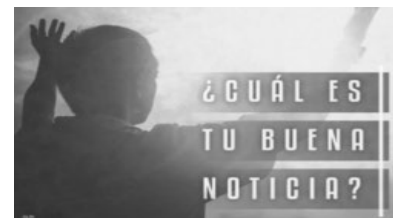
Now it is time to remember to go to God. Sometimes our lives are so confused and tangled that it is difficult to see the Word and hand of God. But when we realize, deep within, the depth of friendship God offers to us it really has the power to turn sadness to joy. The promise is fulfilled. Going frequently to God’s Word, allowing ourselves to be enriched and rejuvenated, and pondering the certainty of God’s fidelity and promise permanently transforms us. We will be more aware of the sacred and the holy and less invested in things that pull us away.

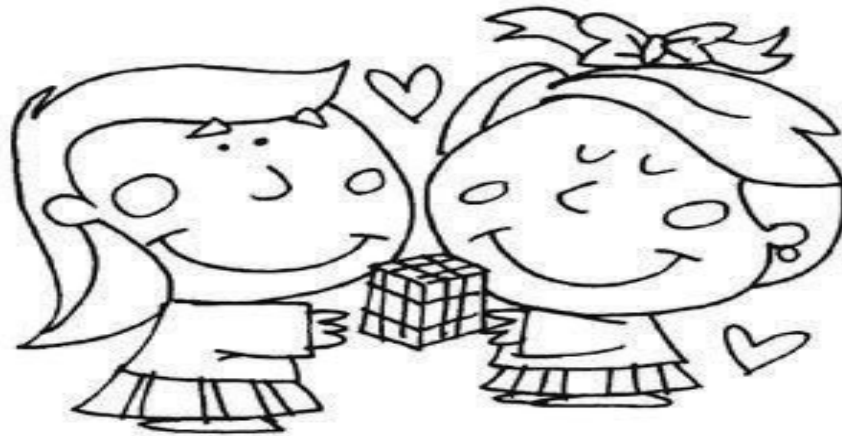
3er Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

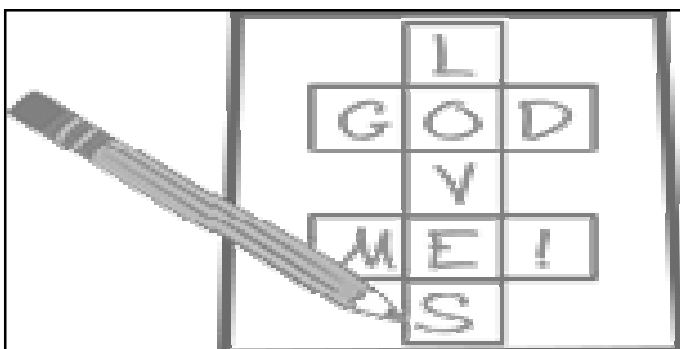

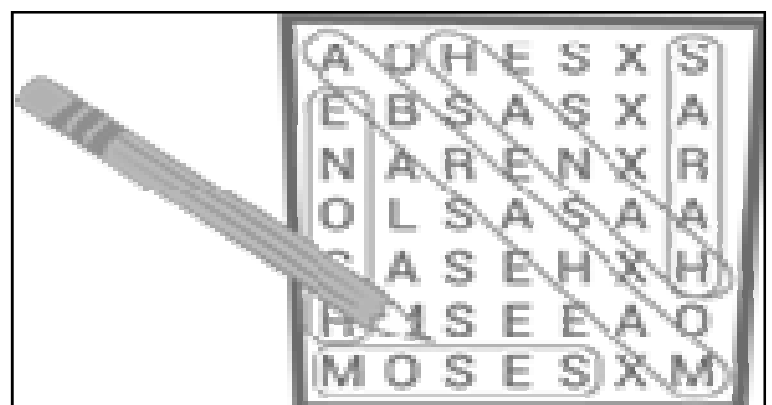
