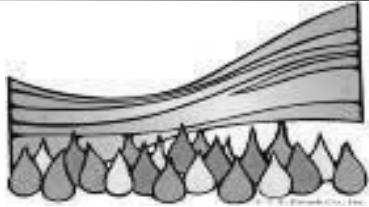

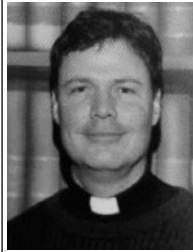

FROM OUR PASTORS DESK



Happy Birthday Catholic Church!

Today we celebrate the feast of Pentecost. We celebrate the Holy Spirit's continuing presence within the church and her people. Do we believe this is true? Do we acknowledge the presence of the Holy Spirit and recognize that presence working in our Church and in each of our individual lives?

It can be hard to imagine the Holy Spirit who prefers to stay out of sight and behind the scenes. Yet, the Spirit is always with us, especially when we gather together in faith and prayer. We call on the Spirit to help us listen to the living Word. We pray on the Spirit to come down upon the bread and wine and change it into Christ's body and blood. The Spirit blesses our inner spirit with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness and humility and self control. The Holy Spirit honors our free will and never forces us in any direction. If we believe and open our heart to the

Spirit then the Spirit inspires us to move in God's direction. Jesus said, "the Spirit will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." As a priest and catholic, without the Spirit I could not live the sacramental life we are all called to live. The Gospel I preach would certainly be my own. My choices, decisions, and actions would become earthly and self motivated.

We have all received, at confirmation, incredible gifts, but can we even name them? At Christmas, birthdays and all those special occasions, when we receive gifts from our family and friends, do we keep them wrapped and stored away? Have we done so with the gifts of the Holy Spirit which assist us in helping others and living a holy life! This Pentecost Sunday we need to ask ourselves if we know, recognize and have opened our hearts to allowing the living fire of the Holy Spirit into our lives!

THE SPIRIT'S ACTIVE POWER

The mystery of the Trinity refers to one God in three persons. We frequently acknowledge Jesus as "the second person of the Trinity," but referring also to the Spirit as a "person" comes less naturally. In religious art, the Holy Spirit often appears as a dove or, as in today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, tongues of fire. Much rarer are images of the Spirit as a "person" in recognizable human form. Today's readings do not settle the issue of how to picture the Spirit, but they certainly give shape to the Spirit's active power in the world and in each human heart. In Acts, the Spirit enables people to speak and understand a variety of languages. Paul's letter to the Corinthians praises the Spirit for all kinds of spiritual gifts, services, and "workings." Finally, in John's Gospel, Jesus calls the Spirit our Advocate and our divine teacher.

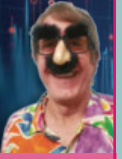
