**As promised, by the Flame of Love Prayer/Study Groups, in last week's bulletin,
The Words Of Our Lord Jesus Regarding Receiving The Sacraments, given to mystic Luisa Piccarreta, in The Book of Heaven:**

"...the Sacraments themselves, if they are not received in harmony with MY WILL can serve as a means to condemnation and ruin" (Vol 17: June 10, 1924).

"...how may souls receive Me Sacramentally in their hearts and place Me in solitude! I feel Myself in them as in a desert, and as if I did not pertain to them; they treat Me as a stranger, ...Souls who receive Me and do not take part in my Sacramental Life, form for Me the most bitter solitude".

"How many times I descend into hearts and Cry because I find Myself alone; and thus, I feel Myself not cared for, nor appreciated, nor loved; so much that I am constrained by their indifference. I await the consummation of the Sacramental Species within which the Eternal 'Fiat' has imprisoned Me. My Real Presence then goes away -- so many souls are seen who receive Me Sacramentally, but do not give to Me; they are barren of virtue, barren of love, of sacrifice they remain devoid of Me". Becoming aware of this need of Jesus, to receive a proper thanksgiving after our Communion, and motivated by your love of Jesus, and your desire to please Him, "resolve to do everything possible so that thanksgiving after Holy Communion lasts at least 15 minutes and nothing takes precedence over it, these minutes should not be wasted."

St Padre Pio said, "Let us see to it that our being unable is not just being unwilling. I always have to make my thanksgiving; otherwise, I pay dearly."

St. Alphonus Liguori said, "Alas! A quarter of an hour is too little."

"... los Sacramentos mismos, si no se reciben en armonía con mi voluntad, pueden servir como un medio para la condenación y la ruina" (Vol 17: 10 de junio de 1924).

"Cuántas veces desciendo a los corazones y lloro porque me encuentro solo; y así, me siento a Mí mismo no cuidado, ni apreciado, ni amado; tanto que estoy limitado por su indiferencia. Espero la consumación de la Especie Sacramental dentro de la cual el 'Fiat' Eterno me ha encarcelado. Mi Presencia Real entonces desaparece, se ven muchas almas que Me reciben Sacramentalmente, pero no me dan; son estériles de virtud, estériles de amor, de sacrificio y permanecen desprovistos de Mí". Tomando conciencia de esta necesidad de Jesús, de recibir una acción de gracias adecuada después de nuestras Comuniones, y motivado por su amor a Jesús, y su deseo de complacerlo, "resuelva hacer todo lo posible para que la acción de gracias después de la Sagrada Comunión dure al menos 15 minutos y nada tenga prioridad sobre ella, estos minutos no deben desperdiciarse".

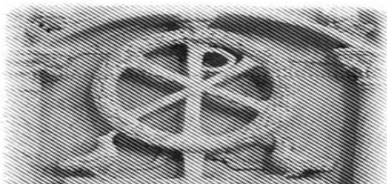

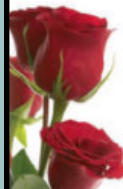
