MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

The Easter season is always a whirlwind of activity at the Parish. We rejoice in the Resurrection of Christ and as the seasons change from Winter to Spring, we see the evidence of "new life in Christ" shining forth in God's creation as the flowers begin to bloom and the trees are filled with green leaves.

Life in the Parish also seems to bloom forth. Weddings and Baptisms, not normally celebrated during Lent, fill the calendar, as well as the celebration of First Communion (April 30th) and Confirmation (May 26th). I was in Chicago last weekend for the wedding of my nephew (also my godson). His father, my brother, was the first wedding I did thirty years ago and my nephew's wedding was my 400th wedding. It was a great family celebration. The Parish came together for the International Food Luncheon and Hospitality Sunday. The Women of Saint Mark celebrated Cinco de Mayo, and no May would be complete without the Knights of Columbus Memorial Day smoked meat sale. Those received into the Church at Easter continued their gathering through the Mystagogia process and celebrated with a Mass and Dinner on May 16th. Families celebrated graduation from all levels of School. Our Easter season will conclude with the opportunity to come together for Solemn Vespers on Pentecost Sunday (June 5th) at 5:00 P.M. in the church. Our reflection that night will be on "the Lord's Prayer in the Gospel of Matthew."

We will welcome a seminarian, Mr. Adam Sellers, (from Demopolis, AL) to our Parish the week of May 23rd. He will be with us through mid-July. Our Diocese will come together and rejoice with the Ordination to the Priesthood of Deacon Charles Deering at the Cathedral of Saint Paul on June 11th at 11:00 A.M.

All this activity also brings with it change. Change is not bad; it is just change. We navigate through change with the help of our God, who constantly reminds us of His loving presence. Some changes will occur on our parish staff over the next few weeks. Mrs. Lindsay Wright, our parish Secretary, will be moving to Georgia with her family. She will continue to manage all our Parish communications activity – bulletins, weekly emails, website, and all social media (Facebook, Instagram, etc). Her email will remain the same secretary@stmarkrc.org. We will welcome to our staff Mrs. Tracy Pflaum as our parish Receptionist. She will "manage" the Parish office. She and her family have been members of Saint Mark the Evangelist for many years. I am excited to welcome her to our Parish Staff. She has been "training" with Lindsay this past week and will "fly solo" on Tuesday.

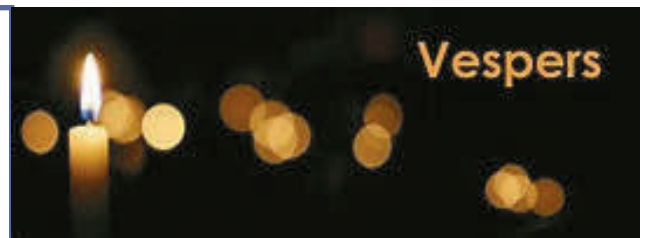
