

### **MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

We welcome Mr. Adam Sellers, a seminarian for our Diocese, to the Parish this Summer. He will be here for 6-8 weeks. He will be writing an article for the Bulletin each week while he is here. Those articles will take the place of my letter.



"In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit". This prayer leads us into the mystery we celebrate this Sunday, the Most Holy Trinity. The Holy Trinity is a life of communion to be lived, shared, and celebrated. Therefore, we need to go beyond talking about love, communion, sharing and putting

that into practice by being instruments of reconciliation, mercy, and communion. Through practicing these virtues, we will sanctify our souls and be better prepared for the life after this one.

In today's Gospel we hear "I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth." Each one of us will eventually be faced with the truth and must confront it. To do this we must first identify and distance ourselves from the impulses and addictions that drive ourselves into sin. After we have done this, we can then live out that truth. But we must remember that we are not left to tackle the most difficult of tasks on our own. Through the Spirit of truth, Jesus continues to speak to us. But he can only help us if we seek that help from him through prayer and living a virtuous life.

When you hear Jesus say that he has much more to say to you. How do you feel about that? Are you, perhaps, afraid of what Jesus might ask of you? Are you afraid to listen to him in case you hear something you don't want to hear? Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you into the truth, and to help you to trust that what Jesus wants will always be lifegiving for you.




