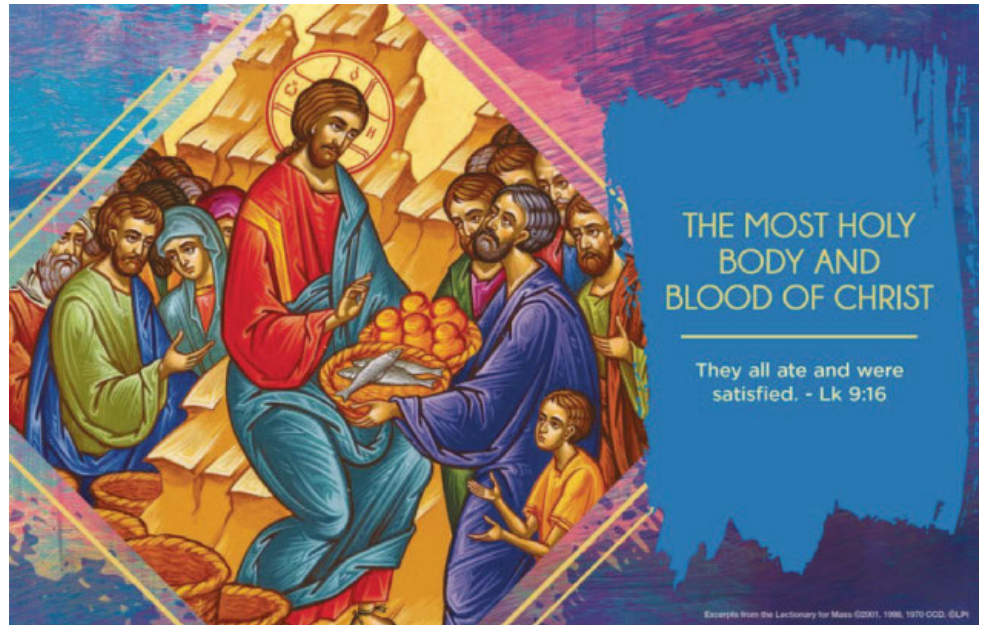

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

We welcome Mr. Adam Sellers, a seminarian for our Diocese, to the Parish this Summer. He will be here for 6-8 weeks. He will be writing an article for the Bulletin each week while he is here. Those articles will take the place of my letter.

Today we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Today is a celebration of the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist and on this day, we recall the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper.

"Corpus Christi is a doctrinal feast established for three purposes: 1) to give God collective thanks for Christ's abiding presence with us in the Eucharist and to honor Him there; 2) to instruct the people in the Mystery, Faith and devotion surrounding the Eucharist, and 3) to teach us to appreciate and make use of the great gift of the Holy Eucharist, both as a Sacrament and as a sacrifice." The great treasure of the Catholic Church is the Eucharist which is Jesus himself hidden under the appearance of bread and wine. Every time we receive the Eucharist it is an opportunity for us to grow closer to Christ and to receive an abundant amount of graces from Him. There is not a more intimate time that we have with our Lord on this earth when we receive Him in the Eucharist and so it is a time for deep prayer. Take the time when kneeling in the pew after communion to give thanks and speak to our Lord about what is going on in your life as if you are speaking to a friend. Too often do we get caught with things to do in our daily lives that we forget to converse with Christ, but there is not a better time to do it than right after receiving Him in the Eucharist.

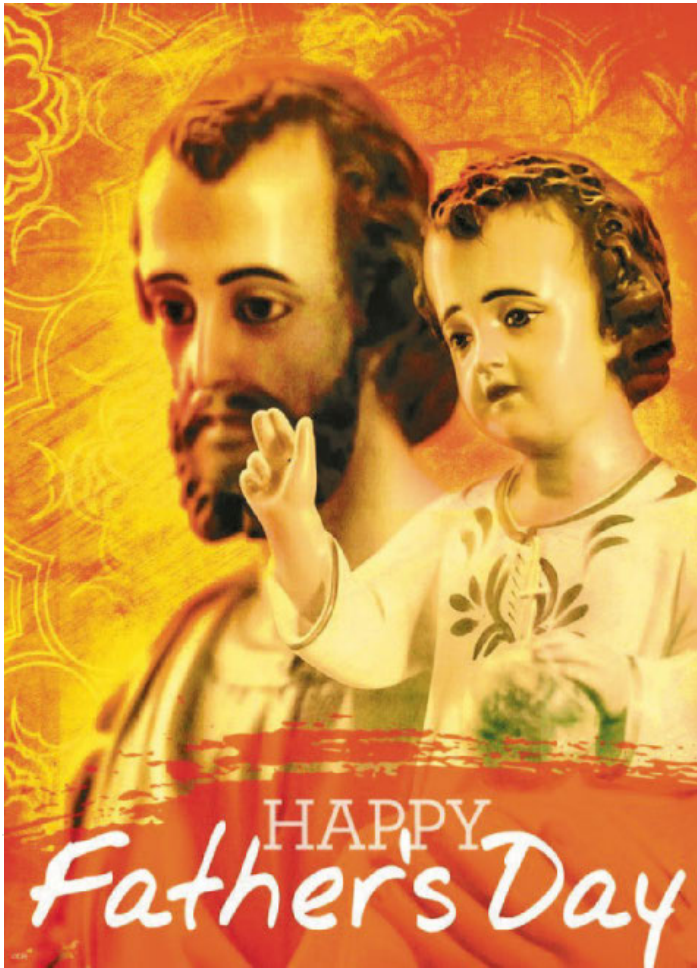
