MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

We welcome Mr. Adam Sellers, a seminarian for our Diocese, to the Parish this Summer. He will be here for 6-8 weeks. He will be writing an article for the Bulletin each week while he is here. Those articles will take the place of my letter.

In today's readings we are left with the radical demands of discipleship. We see it first when Elisha is called from home to follow Elijah. And we see it again when Paul writes of living by the Spirit and not by the flesh.

Sometimes even when what Christ wants for us is obvious it can be difficult answering that call. Even though I was a cradle Catholic it wasn't until my junior year at Auburn when I finally began to take my faith seriously after years of living by the flesh and not the spirit. Shortly after this conversion in college I was challenged again as a disciple of Christ when a friend asked me if I had ever considered seminary. At first, I ignored this call but by doing so I began to have a feeling of uneasiness in my life. And so, when the question pursued me in prayer and other aspects of life, I realized that it was from Christ and that I owed it to him to answer that call. By doing so the feeling of uneasiness left me and I feeling of overwhelming peace began to settle in.

I tell you this story because sometimes the Lord calls us to do things that seem rather difficult or opposes what we might want for ourselves but only God knows what will bring closer to him.

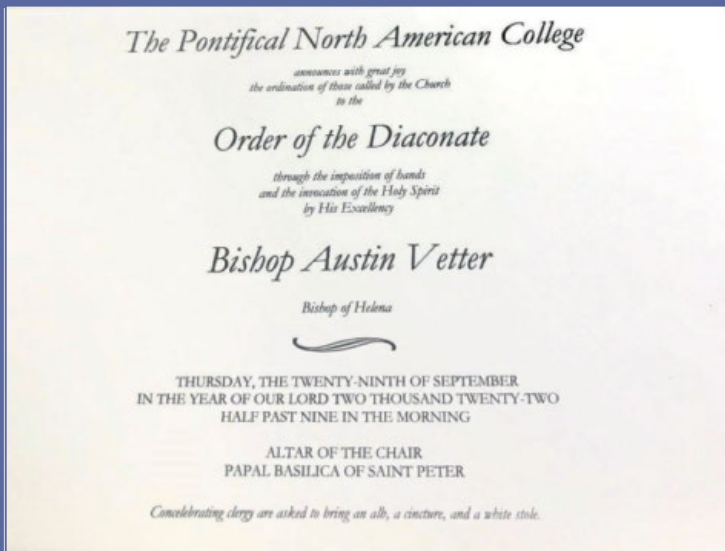
