

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

This weekend our Bishop has asked that as part of our two -and-a-half-year celebration of the Eucharist that we celebrate the Solemnity of Saint John Vianney, the patron saint of Parish Priests. For we are reminded that "without priests, we do not have the Eucharist." So, on this weekend we remember Saint John Vianney and ask for his intercession for an increase in vocations to the priesthood in our Diocese.

A vocation is something we are, not something we do. In the course of a lifetime, people hold many jobs. A young girl may begin as an aide in a day care. Then she may become an Early Childhood teacher. After a while, she may change professions and become a manager of a store. She may even go into investing and become a financial consultant. People have many jobs and many careers. But this is not who they are, it is just something they are currently doing.

A vocation is something that we are. That same girl may become a consecrated religious, or a wife and then a mother. Consecrated Religious, wife and mother are not jobs, they are who she is. They are vocations. The same holds true for men. Husband, father, and priest are not careers that can be changed as some might change jobs.

When Jesus called Simon and Andrew, James, and John, you, and me, He did not call us to do something. He called us to be something. He called us to be disciples. He also called some of us to serve Him and the Church by being priests, religious and deacons. Let us actively support these vocations in our homes.

I would like to offer a prayer that comes from a pamphlet published by the Diocese of Birmingham about 20 years ago called "Daily Prayers for Vocations."

"O God who wills not the death of a sinner, but rather that he or she be converted and live, grant we beseech you through the intercession of the Blessed Mary, ever Virgin, St. Joseph her spouse, and all the saints, an increase in laborers for your Church: fellow laborers with Christ to spend and consume themselves for souls, through the same Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit world without end. Amen."


