Novena, Explained

The word novena comes from the Latin word, novem, for nine. A novena is a nine-day period of private or public prayer. There are four basic categories of novenas — novenas of preparation, of mourning, of prayer, and of indulgence.

The nine days of prayer format comes directly from scripture where we read in the book of Acts that it was nine days after the Ascension that the Holy Spirit descended onto the Apostles. During that time, the faithful men and women “devoted themselves to constant prayer,” (Acts 1:12-14) waiting for the Lord.

Today, Catholics can find hundreds of novenas to pray about a plethora of topics. Many Catholics pray novenas in times of need or in devotion to a specific saint. Although a saint’s novena may traditionally begin or end on the saint’s feast day, while others, like the “Novena for Adopted Children” or the “Novena for Vocations,” can be prayed any time of the year, there is flexibility here for those wanting to pray. The faithful may choose to pray a private novena on any topic at any time! Want to pray a novena to St. Francis but it’s not his feast day? Go ahead!

BAPTISM SEMINAR April 1, 2025

The next Baptism Seminar will be held April 1st at 6:30pm in the convent. These seminars are held on a monthly basis. 

BAGS OF HOPE

When you give alms this Lent, please remember the schoolchildren in Houma who are food-insecure – that is, apart from the free school breakfast and lunch programs, they aren't certain where their next meal might be. "Bags of Hope" is a local non-profit organization providing bags of snacks each Friday to these children. This is used to supply the food pantry in school from which the teachers assemble bags and then distribute to their students. Additionally, BOH is supplying snacks to "Hope Extreme" which ministers to the homeless children who go through their program. On average, this is about 40 homeless children each month. Microwavable mac-n-cheese, ravioli, or soup; granola bars, individual boxes of cereal, pop tarts, individual bags of cookies, chips, pringles, goldfish, pretzels, cheese crackers, fruit snacks. Remember no peanut butter or any snacks containing nuts due to food allergies.




Altar Society

As the Cathedral of St. Francis de Sales Altar Society begins its annual membership drive, the group gratefully acknowledges those who were part of this ministry and supported it in 2024. The Altar Society provides and cares for all the altar linens - altar cloths, purificators and towels. In addition to care of the altar linens, the group cares for the cassocks and surplices worn by the altar servers. In past years, the Altar Society has purchased altar cloths, priest vestments, and joined with the Society of St. Joseph to purchase new altar server cassocks and surplices; and the addition of more animals for the nativity set. The group assists in preparations for the diocesan Chrism Mass and dispensing of Holy Oils during Holy Week; assists with preparation for the Memorial Mass for those buried from St. Francis during the year; assists with various parish and diocesan celebrations. Throughout the year, members change altar cloths in accordance with the liturgical seasons (Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter, and Ordinary Time) and special holy days and celebrations. Altar flowers are donated during the year.

Membership dues/donations are now being accepted - \$10. All parishioners are invited to be members. Two types of membership are available. Active members take an active part in the different areas of the ministry. Inactive members support the ministry through prayer and/or donations. Envelopes are available on the tables at the doors of the Cathedral and may be returned in the Sunday collection or by mail. Current officers are Marie Alsabrook, CoOrdinator/President and Dale Norred, Secretary/Treasurer. Continued support of this parish ministry is appreciated.


