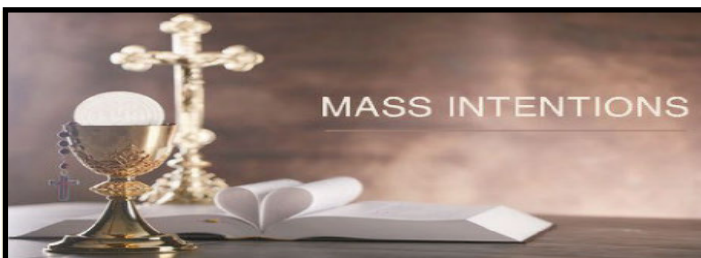

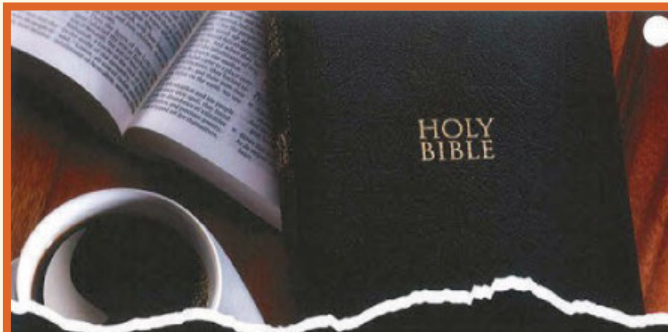

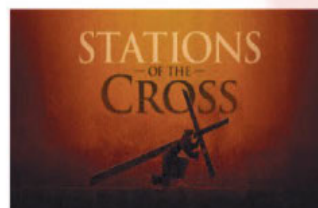

Advance Stewardship Reflection on the Lectionary Readings for Bulletins **June 8, 2025, Pentecost Sunday, Mass during the Day**

[ACTS 1:1-11; PS 104:1, 24, 29-30, 31, 34; 1 COR 12:3B-7, 12-13 or ROM 8:8-17; JN 20:19-23 or JN 14:15-16, 23B-26](#)

Today we reach the finale of the Easter season with the celebration of the great Feast of Pentecost. Reflecting on today's readings inspires a sense of awe as we consider the mighty power of the Holy Spirit at work giving birth to and sustaining our Church. Just as awesome — the same Spirit is calling to us this day to take up our part in the Church's saving work.

In the first reading, from Acts, we see the creative genius of the Holy Spirit moving through the newly confirmed Apostles "who began to speak in different tongues as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim." The large crowd, gathered from all over the world were "amazed" and "astounded" that each one could understand the Apostles speaking in their own language.

Each one of us, young and old alike, is personally called today by the Holy Spirit into the same mission as that of the first Apostles — to advance the Kingdom of God in our corner of the world. Just as He did on that Pentecost day, the Holy Spirit speaks to us in our "own language" to give us the Good News of the Gospel and urge us to share it. We can think of our own language as the particular gifts, talents, and passions we possess. We experience the presence of the Holy Spirit through them and we are meant put them to the work in grateful service of the Kingdom of God.

When we consider the stewardship way of life we are called to live, we often focus on the challenges it poses. Surrendering ourselves to God is indeed a challenging way to live. But it leads to a life that is exciting, creative, and deeply rewarding. Stewardship allows us to experience life as a great adventure because it is a life guided and directed by the very source of power and creativity—the Holy Spirit!

Reflexión anticipada de la corresponsabilidad sobre las lecturas del leccionario para los boletines **8 de junio de 2025, Domingo de Pentecostés, Misa durante el Día**

[HECHOS 1:1-11; SALMO 104:1, 24, 29-30, 31, 34; 1 COR 12:3B-7, 12-13 o ROM 8:8-17; JN 20:19-23 o JN 14:15-16, 23B-26](#)

Hoy llegamos al final de la temporada de Pascua con la celebración de la gran Fiesta de Pentecostés. Reflexionar sobre las lecturas de hoy inspira un sentido de asombro al considerar el poderoso poder del Espíritu Santo en acción, dando vida y sosteniendo nuestra Iglesia. Igualmente asombroso — el mismo Espíritu nos llama en este día a asumir nuestra parte en la obra salvadora de la Iglesia.

En la primera lectura de los Hechos, vemos el genio creativo del Espíritu Santo moviéndose a través de los nuevos Apóstoles "que comenzaron a hablar en diferentes lenguas a medida que el Espíritu les daba capacidad para proclamar." La gran multitud, reunida de todo el mundo, estaba "asombrada" y "estupefacta" de que cada uno pudiera entender a los Apóstoles hablando en su propio idioma.

Cada uno de nosotros, jóvenes y ancianos por igual, somos llamados personalmente hoy por el Espíritu Santo a la misma misión que la de los primeros Apóstoles: avanzar el Reino de Dios en nuestro rincón del mundo. Así como lo hizo en aquel día de Pentecostés, el Espíritu Santo nos habla en nuestro "propio idioma" para darnos la Buena Nueva del Evangelio y alentarnos a compartirla. Podemos pensar en nuestro propio idioma como los dones, talentos y pasiones particulares que poseemos. Experimentamos la presencia del Espíritu Santo a través de ellos y estamos llamados a ponerlos en acción en un servicio agradecido al Reino de Dios.

Cuando consideramos el estilo de vida de corresponsabilidad al que estamos llamados a vivir, a menudo nos centramos en los desafíos que plantea. Rendirse a Dios es, sin duda, una forma de vivir desafiante. Pero conduce a una vida que es emocionante, creativa y profundamente gratificante. La corresponsabilidad nos permite experimentar la vida como una gran aventura porque es una vida guiada y dirigida por la misma fuente de poder y creatividad: ¡el Espíritu Santo!
