Regina Caeli

During the Easter season, consider praying a special Easter prayer called Regina Caeli (Queen of Heaven). Traditionally, the Angelus, which is a prayer that commemorates the moment when God became conceived in Mary's womb, is prayed at 6am, noon, and 6pm. During the Easter season, the Regina Caeli is prayed instead, and we rejoice with Mary at the resurrection of our Lord. See below for the prayer. God bless!

R. For He whom you did merit to bear, alleluia.
V. Has risen, as He said, alleluia.
R. Pray for us to God, alleluia.
V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary, alleluia.
R. For the Lord is truly risen, alleluia.

O God, who gave joy to the world through the Resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, grant, we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may obtain the joys of everlasting life.

FOOD PANTRY

Are we not supposed to eat meat on Fridays?

You may wonder why this is even a question since lent is over.

Canon law tell us: "Abstinence from meat, or from some other food as determined by the Episcopal Conference, is to be observed on all Fridays... (Can. 1251)"

Then why is this not observed?

The Episcopal Conference of the United States issued a document in November 18, 1966 called "Pastoral Statement on Penance and Abstinence" stating that we can replace the abstinence of meat with a more meaning sacrifice, but it remained that among all the forms of penance they still "give first place to abstinence from flesh meat."

The following are some other quotes from that document:

"renunciation of the eating of meat is not always and for everyone the most effective means of practicing penance."

"renunciation of other things would be more penitential"

"far from downgrading the traditional penitential observance of Friday, and motivated precisely by the desire to give the spirit of penance greater vitality "

"more profound penitential conversion"

Unfortunately, many people interpreted it as, "we can eat meat now" and we have lost the concept of doing penance on Fridays.

Fridays, all year, not just Lent, remain days of penance and abstinence, in honoring and remembering the passion and death of our Lord, which happened on a Friday. We can choose to abstain from meat as the norm, or do a more meaningful sacrifice, not something less meaningful.

Our goal is conversion and to remember more the passion of our Lord.

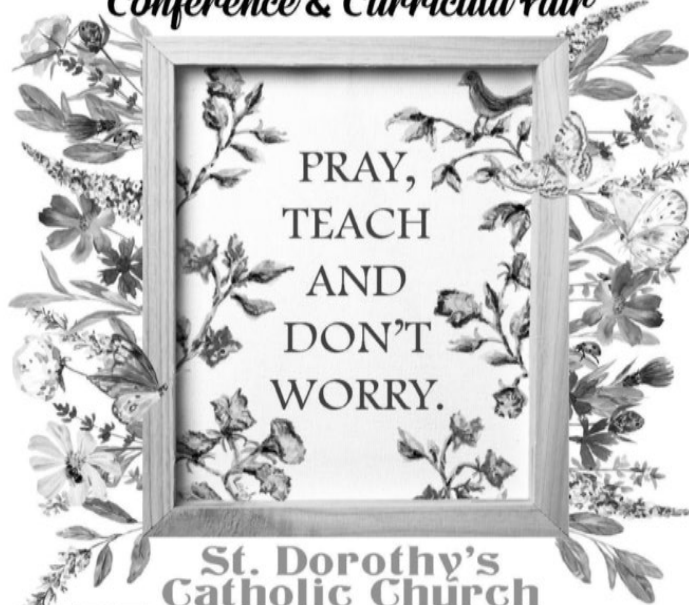

¿No se supone que debemos comer carne los viernes?

Quizás se pregunten por qué esto es una pregunta, ya que la Cuaresma ya terminó.

El derecho canónico nos dice: «La abstinencia de carne, o de cualquier otro alimento según lo determine la Conferencia Episcopal, debe observarse todos los viernes... (Can. 1251)».

Entonces, ¿por qué no se observa esto?

La Conferencia Episcopal de los Estados Unidos emitió un documento el 18 de noviembre de 1966 titulado «Declaración Pastoral sobre la Penitencia y la Abstinencia», en el que se afirma que podemos sustituir la abstinencia de carne por un sacrificio más significativo, pero se mantiene que, entre todas las formas de penitencia, «se sigue dando prioridad a la abstinencia de carne». Las siguientes son otras citas de ese documento:

“Renunciar a comer carne no siempre ni para todos es el medio más eficaz para practicar la penitencia”.

“Renunciar a otras cosas sería más penitencial”.

“Lejos de degradar la tradicional observancia penitencial del viernes, y motivado precisamente por el deseo de dar mayor vitalidad al espíritu de penitencia”.

“Conversión penitencial más profunda”.

Desafortunadamente, muchos lo interpretaron como “ya podemos comer carne” y hemos perdido el concepto de hacer penitencia los viernes.

Los viernes, durante todo el año, no solo la Cuaresma, siguen siendo días de penitencia y abstinencia, en honor y recuerdo de la pasión y muerte de nuestro Señor, que tuvo lugar un viernes. Podemos elegir abstenernos de la carne como norma, o hacer un sacrificio más significativo, no algo menos significativo. Nuestro objetivo es la conversión y recordar más la pasión de nuestro Señor.

Regina Caeli

Durante el tiempo de Pascua, considere rezar una oración especial de Pascua llamada Regina Caeli (Reina del Cielo). Tradicionalmente, el Ángelus, que es una oración que conmemora el momento en que Dios fue concebido en el vientre de María, se reza a las 6 a. m., al mediodía y a las 6 p. m.

Durante el tiempo de Pascua, se reza el Regina Caeli y nos alegramos con María por la resurrección de nuestro Señor. Vea la oración a continuación. ¡Que Dios te bendiga!

V. Reina del Cielo, alégrate, aleluya.

R. Porque el Señor, a quien has llevado en tu vientre, aleluya.

V. Ha resucitado según su palabra, aleluya.

R. Ruega al Señor por nosotros, aleluya.

V. Goza y alégrate Virgen María, aleluya.

R. Porque en verdad ha resucitado el Señor, aleluya.

Oremos.

Oh Dios, que por la resurrección de Tu Hijo, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, has llenado el mundo de alegría, concédenos, por intercesión de su Madre, la Virgen María, llegar a los gozos eternos. Por Jesucristo Nuestro Señor. Amen.

DID YOU KNOW?

What to do if a child discloses abuse

If a child tells you about sexual abuse, the first and most important step to take is to listen to him or her. Let the child fully express the situation and how he or she is feeling. It's important to be aware that children may not always disclose abuse in clear terms. Let the child know that you are listening, and that you believe him or her. Remind him or her of how brave it is to disclose this, and that you will help. Report any suspicion of abuse to authorities. 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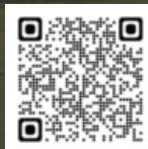
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OUR MISSION STATEMENT
