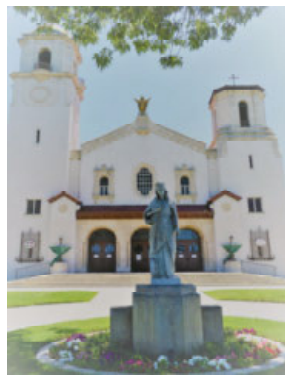

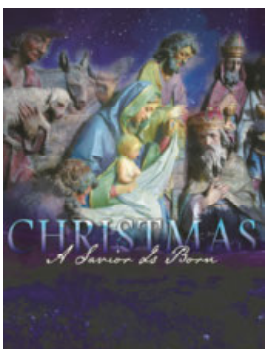

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Brothers and Sisters,

Rejoice! This Sunday is Gaudate Sunday, Rejoice Sunday. As a sign of our joyful anticipation, the color of purple we have seen in our church environment has been replaced by a rose colored altar and ambo cloths as well as the vestments of our priests. The entrance antiphon for today’s liturgy echoes our second reading from Philippians., “Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say rejoice.” Additionally, today’s second reading has always been associated with Gaudate Sunday. The joyful nature of the season of Advent is especially in today’s readings. Here is a bit of humor to bring a smile to your lips: A priest friend of mine calls today “Pepto Bismal Sunday” referring the colors today.



The prayers, readings and hymns of Advent seem to echo the urgency that many of us feel as Christmas approaches. Lifting up our minds and hearts we pray and sing in joyful, watchful hope to hear the voice which announces the birth of Christ. In the midst of loose ends and unfinished plans, we pray simple prayers that our hearts be lifted up and the hope of the season not be lost on us. The joy of this Sunday is a joy that guards against anxiety and above all, an interior peace in the Lord.

In today’s first reading we hear from the prophet Zephaniah who calls for nothing less than the total conversion of oneself to the Lord God. Both the first reading and the gospel urge the reader to wait with joyful expectation. In the second reading Paul urges people to be magnanimous towards one another, to stretch forbearance as far as it can be stretched for the sake of unity in the community. He points to a reason for quarrels and disputes to end: community lives are a reflection of Christ. People will be attracted to Christ (or not) by the way Christians act towards one another in love.

John the Baptist does the preparatory work for Jesus who is to follow him. John has come to stress the *Word* that was spoken to him. John is a symbol of the preaching ministry and reminds us that we are all called to preach the Living Word of God. As we heard last week, John the Baptist emerged from the desert, calling for all people to repent and be baptized, for the Kingdom of God was at hand. The crowds had practical questions about what they should do beyond being baptized by John. So John gives them simple advise. Share with those who have nothing. Much later, we hear Jesus tell his disciples that when they do something for the least of their sisters and brothers, they do it for him. When out of kindness, we share what we have with those in need, the Lord is near. He is in our neighbor in need.

We find the message of these words in the Sioux proverb: “First you are to think always of God. Second you are to use all your power to care for your people and especially the poor.”

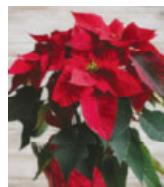

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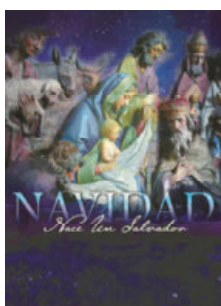

MEDITACIÓN EVANGÉLICO

3er Domingo de Adviento

El tercer domingo de Adviento es conocido como Gaudete, una palabra en latín que significa “gozo”, y se basa en la Carta de San Pablo a los Filipenses: “*Estén siempre alegres en el Señor; se lo repito, estén alegres y tengan buen trato con todos*” (Filipenses 4:4). Estas palabras resumen prácticamente lo que estamos viviendo cada día que pasa y nos acerca al nacimiento de nuestros Salvador. La alegría aumenta en nuestros corazones y nos impulsa a estar más preparados en dos aspectos importantes. Espiritualmente y en la preparación de la fiesta en casa para el día de Navidad. ¿Qué pensamos hacer? ¿A cuál Eucaristía asistiremos en familia para agradecer a Jesús su bondad y misericordia?

María y Juan Bautista nos muestran el camino. Nos indican que somos llamados a dar testimonio de la luz, a ser valientes, a sabernos retirar a tiempo para señalarle y otros lo vean y lo sigan. “*Yo los bautizo con agua, pero está por llegar uno con más poder que yo, y yo no soy digno de desatar las correas de su sandalia. Él los bautizará con el Espíritu Santo y el fuego. Tiene la pala en sus manos para separar el trigo de la paja. Guardará el trigo en sus graneros, mientras que la paja la quemará en el fuego que no se apaga*” (Lucas 3:16-17). Aquí está la clave de hoy, ¿somos trigo o somos paja? ¿Dónde nos colocará el Señor? 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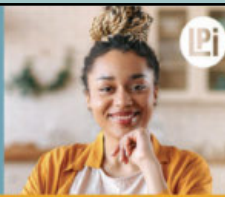
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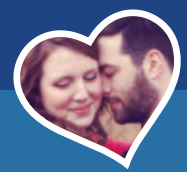


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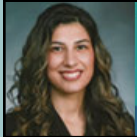
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
