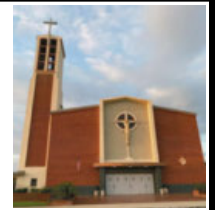

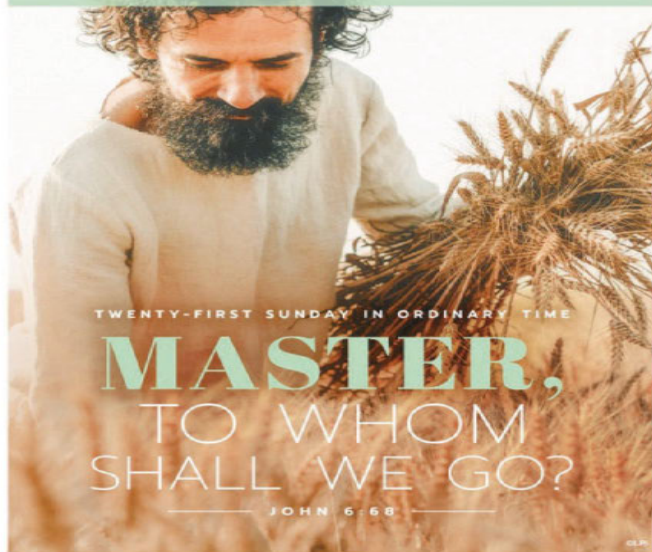

**AUGUSTINIAN FEASTS—AUGUST 27 & 28, 2024****HONORING****ST. MONICA, MOTHER OF ST. AUGUSTINE**

The church celebrates on Tuesday and Wednesday, August 27 & 28, 2024, the Feasts of St. Monica and her son St. Augustine, at all the Masses.

In 331 or 332 Monica was born at Tagaste (Algeria) into a dedicated Christian Family of good social standing. As a young woman she married Patritius, a non-Christian, who was a modest landowner and a city counselor in Togaste. Monica was an ideal Christian wife and mother, with her courage of soul, warmth of faith, strength of hope, keenness of intellect, constancy of prayer and meditation on the Holy Scripture, together with a sensible approach to the ups and downs of family life. She succeeded in bringing about the conversion to Christ of both her husband and Augustine, "the son of many tears," at whose baptism she was present with a heart brimful of joy. On her way back to Africa with Augustine and his friends, she died at Ostia on the Tiber (outside Rome) some time in the month of October 385—it was certainly before November 13. She was 55 years old. It was about two weeks before her death that mother and son experienced the rapture of the "ecstasy of Ostia," in which "for one brief moment, with a sweep of their hearts they reached up to Wisdom, the Maker of all things, and left with him the first fruits of their spirits.": St. Monica's remains are venerated in the church of St. Augustine, Rome. **On Tuesday, August 27th, we celebrate the feast of St. Monica, mother of St. Augustine, with a reception at St. Augustine House after the 8:00 a.m. Mass.**

AND**ST. AUGUSTINE, BISHOP & DOCTOR OF THE CHURCH**

The life span of St. Augustine (354-430) covered a time of crisis and change. The Roman Empire was slowly disintegrating under the invasions of the surrounding peoples. On August 28, Hippo was already under siege. So while Augustine lay dying, this drama of events was intensely alive, and although his mind was fixed on God, he could not but have been a co-suffer with his people in their plight. From the time of his priestly ordination (391) and especially since he became bishop (395) his people had been one with him in seeking God's glory through the service of their Church. Wishing to live this unity more clearly himself, he founded religious communities. These he saw as centers and symbols of his ideal. Augustine is now dead, but as Saint Possidius said he still lives on gloriously in the books he left to posterity.

On Wednesday, August 28th, we celebrate the feast of St. Augustine, Bishop and Doctor of the Church, with a reception at St. Augustine House after the 8:00 a.m., and a Mass at 7:00 p.m., followed by refreshments and goodies in the parish hall. All are invited to attend.

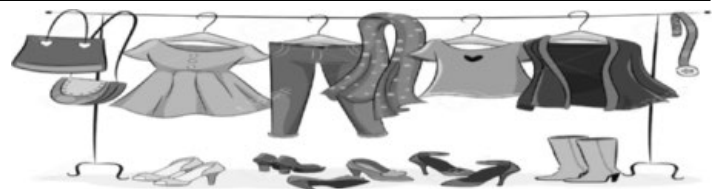

FIESTA AGUSTINA—27 Y 28 DE AGOSTO, 2024

EN HONOR DE

SANTA MONICA, MADRE DE SAN AGUSTIN

La iglesia celebrara el martes y miercoles, 27 y 28 de Agosto, 2024, en todas las Misas las fiestas de Santa Monica y su hijo San Agustín.

En el año 331 o 332 nació Mónica en Tagaste (Alegría) en una familia cristiana y de buen rango social. Siendo jovencita se casó con Patritius, un no-Cristiano, hacendolo y consejero civil en Tagaste, Mónica era una esposa y madre crisitana ideal, con alma valiente, fe cálidad, esperanza fuerte, intelecto agudo, constante en oración y meditación en la Sagrada Escritura, junto con todos los cotidianos de la vida familiar. Logró la conversión a Cristo de ambos su esposo y Agustín, "el hijo de tantas lágrimas", en cuyo bautismo estuvo Creador de todas las cosas, y le dejaron los primeros frutos de sus espíritus". Se veneran los restos de Sta. Mónica en la iglesia de San Agustín de Roma. **El martes, 27 de Agosto, celebramos la Fiesta de Santa Monica, Madre de San Agustín, en la Casa San Agustín despues de la Misa a las 8:00 a.m.**

SAN AGUSTIN, OBISPO Y DOCTOR DE LA IGLESIA

La vida de San Agustín (354-430) cubrió un tiempo de crisis y cambio. El emperio Romano iba destingerándose poco a poco bajo las invasions de pueblos cercanos. Para el 28 de Agosto, Hippo ya estaba bajo sitio. Mientras Agustín moría, este drama de eventos estaba intensamente vivo, y aunque su mente ahora estaba fija en Dios, no pudo haber sufrido con su pueblo estuuo unido a él en busca de la Gloria de Dios a través del servicio a su iglesia, mientras una de sus más grandes aspiraciones era la promoción de unidad en la iglesia entera. Deseando vivir esta unidad más aun, fundó comunidades religiosas. Estas las vió como centros y símbolos de su ideal. Agustín ya está muerto, pero Sto. Posidius dijo que aun vive gloriosamente en los libros que dejo a posteridad.

El miercoles, 28 de agosto, celebramos la fiesta de San Agustín, Obispo y Doctor, con una recepcion en la Casa San Agustín despue de la Misa a las 8:00 a.m. y con Misa a las 7:00 p.m., seguida por refrescos y golocinas hechos en casa, en el Salón Parroquial. Todas las personas serán bienvenidos.

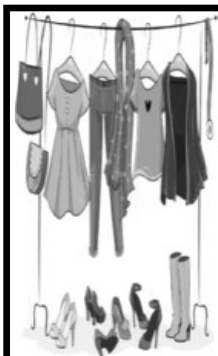

**RCIA
"Rite of Christian Initiation
of
Adults"**

Forty years ago, St. Benedict Parish start-
ed the RCIA Process. RCIA stands for the
"Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults." The rite
is based on the way the Christian Church in
the early centuries brought in new members. The rite
takes place in stages and is geared to helping people
develop a closer relationship with God, understanding
Christianity more deeply, in particular Catholic Christiani-
ty, and to live out the Christian faith.

Adults of various ages and backgrounds participate in
RCIA. Among them are non-Christians and Christians
from other denominations seeking to know more about
the Catholic Faith, some but not all, with the intent of
joining the Catholic Church. Some people are adult
Catholics preparing to receive the Sacrament of Eucha-
rist (Communion) and/or the Sacrament of Confirmation.
Participants in RCIA have no commitment to joining, be-
ing confirmed in, or being involved in the Catholic
Church unless they choose it.

RCIA sessions include input, discussion, sharing, pray-
ers, etc., and a time for participants to ask questions. **If
you are interested, please attend a meeting which will
take place on Wednesdays, beginning September 4,
2024, at 7:00 p.m., in St. Augustine House, 200 N. 12th St.,
Montebello, Calif.**

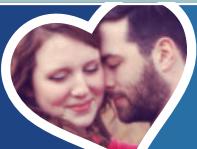
