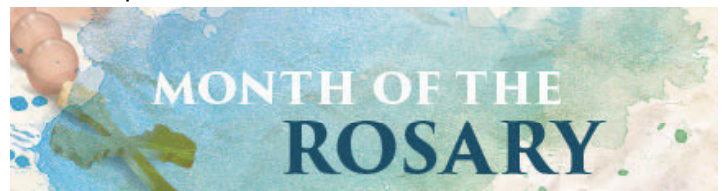
MASS SERVICE UPDATE

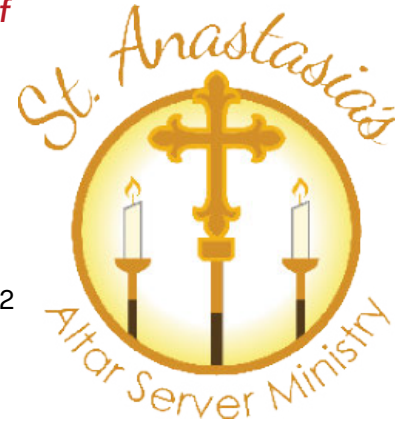


ALTAR SERVER MINISTRY

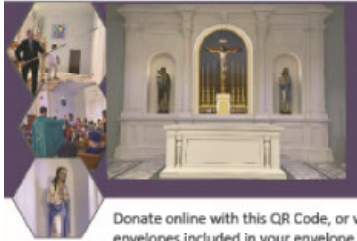
Talking With Your Children

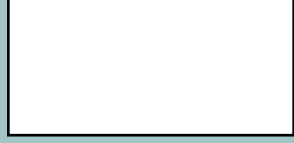

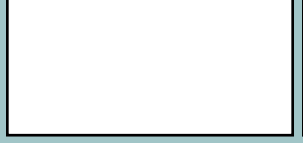
