Keeping children safe in holiday crowds

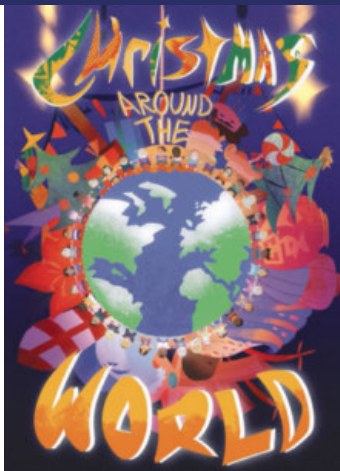
