## MESSAGE FROM FATHER JONATHAN

On June 16<sup>th</sup> I walked into the church to prepare for Benediction, and I noticed many more people than normal gathered on a Friday evening. I knew that a rosary had been planned at 4:30pm to pray in reparation for sins and whatever other intentions we needed to bring to our Lord, especially as we celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus that day. I was truly surprised with how many people had shown up for the rosary, and that nearly everyone had stayed for Benediction. This witness truly showed the power of prayer. Yes, many had gathered because of the hurt they felt with the Dodgers inviting the Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence. I know I was hurt. We experienced what Jeremiah experienced from the first reading in today's liturgy (Jer. 20:10-13). Jeremiah has been betrayed by his friends. He has been deeply hurt by those who were closest to him. We may have felt that way with the Dodgers, and just like Jeremiah we continued to put our trust in God. We proclaimed from the housetops of our hearts the Good News of God, that Jesus Christ is Lord, and that His love will always prevail. As I end my time here at OLPH, I am thankful for the great witness we have shown in times of persecution and in times of triumph. I am thankful that we as a community are doing our best to grow in love with Christ, especially Christ in the Most Holy Eucharist. I am also thankful for all you have done for me. You welcomed me into the OLPH family with open hearts and open arms, during one of the most confusing times of our lives. You welcomed this hometown boy when I was most vulnerable, having just been moved from another parish. Serving here at OLPH for the first 3 years of my priesthood has been nothing short of amazing. I have grown as a priest and a person, all thanks to you. Please know that you all have a special place in my heart, and you will always be remembered in my prayers. God bless you all! Fr. Jonathan

## CELEBRATIONS IN HONOR OF THE SOLEMNITY OF OUR LADY OF PERPETUAL HELP



This Tuesday, is the feast day of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, the patroness of our parish.

Devotion to our Lady as a Perpetual Help is inspired by a Byzantine icon of unknown origin that depicts the Madonna and Child with the Archangels Michael and Gabriel that has been a focus of devotion in Rome since 1499. This icon was entrusted to the Redemptorist Order by Pope Pius IX in 1865 and currently is enshrined in the Church of Saint Alphonsus Liguori in Rome.

We will honor her at our two usual morning Masses scheduled at 7:00 a.m. and 8:15 a.m. We have also scheduled a special bi-lingual Mass in her honor at 7:00 p.m. The special collection we will take at these Masses is dedicated to support our parish religious education programs. If you are not able to be present for the Masses, you can make a special offering for her feast day via *Faith Direct*.

Please plan to join us to celebrate our wonderful patroness!

## FOURTH OF JULY SCHEDULE

On Independence Day, Tuesday, July 4, we will celebrate only one Mass, at 8:15 a.m. Please note that because of the annual Santa Clarita Independence Day Parade, on that morning **street closures will begin as early as 6:00 a.m. and Lyons Avenue is usually closed to traffic entirely by around 7:30 a.m.**

Thus, if you are planning to come to the 8:15 a.m. Mass by automobile, please be aware of these closures. You may wish to park several blocks away in locations that will not be blocked and then walk the final distance to church. If you wish to park in the church parking lot that morning, you need to arrive early. In that case, plan to stay and watch the parade in front of the church since cars will not be able to leave our lot until after the parade is completed.

The Pastoral Center will be closed for the Independence Day. It will reopen at the usual time, Wednesday, July 5.

## SAINTS TO CELEBRATE THIS WEEK

This week we go far back in time to remember a variety of saints from the very first centuries of our Church's existence as well as another saint directly connected to us in southern California.

On Wednesday, June 28, we celebrate the **Memorial of St. Irenaeus** (circa 130 – 220), Bishop of Lyons in what is now France. Irenaeus was a disciple of St. Polycarp, and Polycarp was a friend of St. John the Evangelist. Thus, Irenaeus benefitted from being close to the apostolic sources of the Church's preaching. He was very influential in confronting what is known as the Gnostic heresy and his writings provide the first comprehensive account of the chief teachings of our faith. His name means "lover of peace" and he did indeed intervene to help resolve a controversy that threatened the unity of the church.

On Thursday, June 29, we celebrate the **Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul**. In parts of the Church this is a holy day of obligation. These two Apostles had a profound impact in their time and continue to inspire us to this day. Peter was, despite his flaws, despite his denials of the Lord, the "rock" who would lead the Church in the first decades of our existence. Paul (Saul), the persecutor of the early Church, encountered Jesus on the road to Damascus and his life was forever transformed. He became the great missionary, the Apostle to the Gentiles. Both were martyred for their commitment to Jesus. On this feast day, you might consider reading the First Letter of Peter (only five chapters long) or some passages from the Acts of the Apostles centering on St. Paul (particularly Acts 7:54 – 8:3 and 9:1-30).

On Saturday, July 1, we celebrate **St. Junipero Serra** (1713-1784) the apostle of California. Arriving in San Diego on July 1, 1769, he founded Mission San Diego de Alcalá, and later eight additional California missions, including San Gabriel and San Buenaventura in our own Archdiocese. Throughout his life he suffered from health problems, an ulcerated leg, asthma, and eventually died of tuberculosis. Despite his suffering, he journeyed far and wide to proclaim the gospel. He is one of the secondary patrons of our Archdiocese.



## DAILY SCRIPTURE READINGS

A great way to learn the Bible and incorporate it into your prayer is to set aside some time each day to reflect on the Scripture readings that are assigned to the daily liturgy. A simple way to do this is to go to the site <https://bible.usccb.org>. This service is also available in Spanish at <https://bible.usccb.org/es>.

Once at the site, you have several options. You can click on the readings for the day and read the texts yourself. There is also a tab for the daily reading podcast in which those Scriptures are verbally proclaimed. Finally, there is a tab for a video, usually about two and a half minutes in length, which presents a variety of speakers offering brief reflections on the meaning of those Scriptures.

### DID YOU KNOW? “FRIEND” YOUR CHILDREN ONLINE

One way to keep up-to-date on what your children are doing online is to actively follow their accounts on social media. Consider including a “friend” policy in your family’s social media rules, where your child has to accept your friend request and give you open access to what they are viewing and posting. Make sure you have your children turn off any settings that allow them to limit how much information friends can view on their pages. You might also consider sharing a password so you can access their direct messages.
