

MESSAGE FROM FR. FRANCIS

Dear Parish Family,

In today's Gospel from John, we encounter Jesus before Pilate, who questions Him about His kingship. Jesus explains, "My kingdom is not of this world." His words reveal the true nature of His reign—a kingdom not based on power or politics, but on truth and love. Jesus tells Pilate, "I came into the world to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice."

This passage challenges us to consider what it means to be part of Christ's kingdom. As members of His Church, we're called to live by His truth, even when it stands against the values of the world. It's a reminder that our true citizenship lies not in earthly allegiances but in God's eternal kingdom. We follow a King who leads with humility, who rules by love, and who calls us to lives of compassion, forgiveness, and service.

In a world often driven by division, competition, and self-interest, Christ the King invites us to reflect His truth through our actions. To belong to His kingdom is to listen to His voice—to be people of peace, hope, and integrity. This week, let's ask ourselves how we can better align our lives with His example, showing others the beauty of a life rooted in Christ's truth and love.

May we always be faithful witnesses to His kingdom, bringing His light to the world around us.

CHRISTIAN MEDITATION

" 'Whatever you are doing put your whole heart into it, as if you were doing it for the Lord and not for others, knowing that there is a Master who will give you your heritage as a reward for your service' (1 Col. 3:23-24). Put your whole heart into it. Meditation calls us to the deepest and clearest level of understanding. Once we begin to meditate, once we have taken the first step, we soon realize that we can no longer remain in the shallows. The call we have responded to is for a complete reorientation of our being, a radical conversion. The call is, above all else, to enter the mystery itself, to learn what cannot be learned anywhere else or in any other way. For this call to be answered, every part of our being has to be involved because the knowledge we come to in meditation is not of a partial or quantative type. It is not that we know more and more about God, or that we know God to be all good, all holy, all just, all merciful and so on. On the contrary, in meditation we come to realize that we know as a consequence of being known. This is not easy either to believe or to understand at first, but we need only remember that in meditation we are entering into the basic relationship of our life. God, our Creator and our Father, calls us into an intimacy with Him that arises because God first knows and loves us. And, in this act of knowing and loving us, God invites us to come into a relationship of knowing and loving Him." Fr. John Main, The Way of Unknowing.



DID YOU KNOW? Child pornography and artificial intelligence, part 1

Many child abusers maintain a "collection" of pornographic materials, including images, either real or fake, of their victims or intended victims. Abusers will often manipulate these images for their own purposes — for example, cropping or editing a photo or a video in a suggestive manner, or adding other elements to create a preferred image. While this is not new behavior, it has become increasingly more dangerous with the introduction of artificial intelligence. SACRAMENTAL SEAL

QUESTION:

What is a sacramental seal and where did it come from?

ANSWER:

Leaving more than just a memory, there are some events in our life that are truly transforming, making us different people. The same thing can be said of spiritual things, especially sacraments. A sacramental seal or character is a theological concept to describe the life-changing and permanent effect of three sacraments on the person: baptism, confirmation, and holy orders. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that these sacraments confer a seal "by which the Christian shares in Christ's priesthood and is made a member of the Church according to different states and functions. This configuration to Christ and the Church, brought about by the Spirit, is indelible" (#1121).


Once we receive these sacraments, we are forever changed. It's a spiritual "point of no return" whereby we take a step forward in our faith journey. We are marked as people of faith, as those who have received the Spirit and as those called to serve in ordained ministry. That is why these sacraments are received only once. The direction is set, the choice is made, and we are called by God to be his people. Nothing can change that, not even our own sinfulness.




