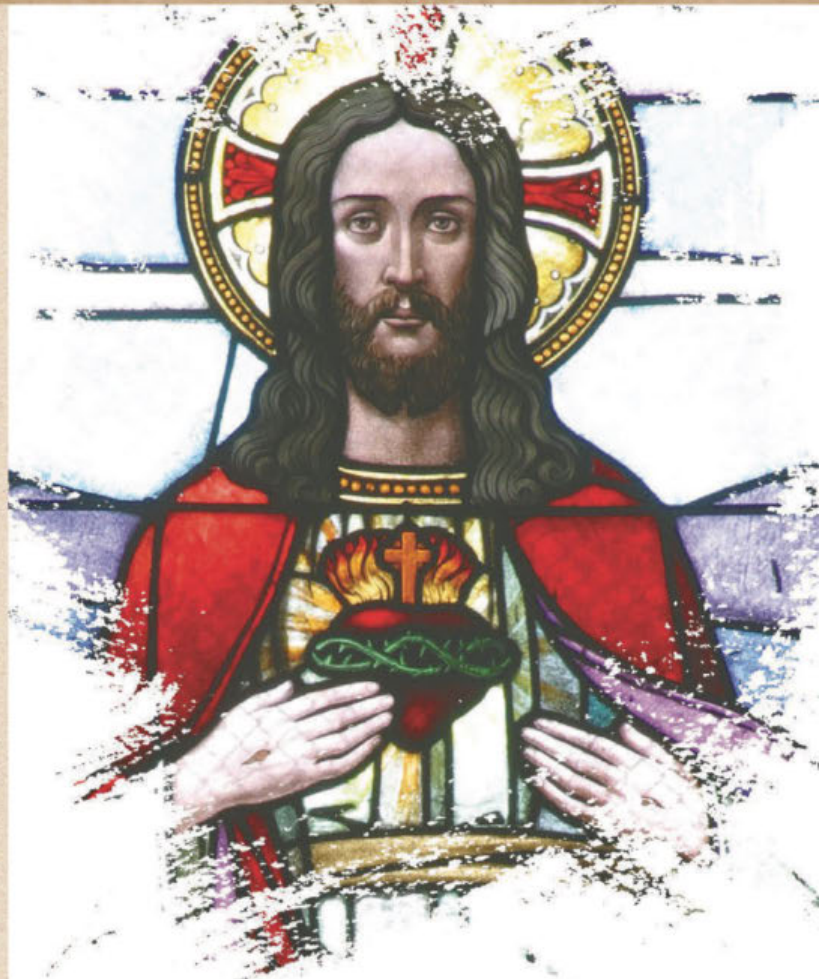

Dear Parish Family,

This Wednesday, we begin our Lenten journey with Ash Wednesday, a solemn day of prayer, fasting, and repentance. As we receive ashes on our foreheads, we hear the words, "**Repent, and believe in the Gospel**" or "**Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return.**" These words remind us of both our human frailty and our call to conversion.

Ash Wednesday is not just a ritual; it is an invitation—an invitation to step away from distractions and reorient our hearts toward God. The ashes, a symbol of humility and repentance, call us to reflect on how we are living our faith and where we need God's grace to grow.

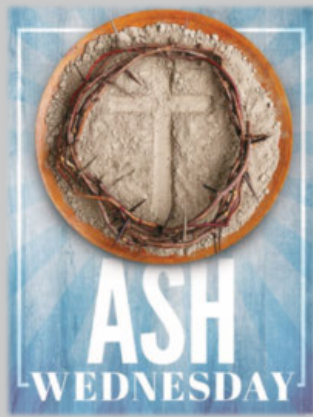

CHRISTIAN MEDITATION

"What are the first questions that anybody asks when they start to meditate? How long does this take? How long will it be before I begin to see the benefits, the fruits, and I can be sure that I'm not wasting my time? How long does it take? This question is asked in the 14th-century book, *The Cloud of Unknowing*, one of the great short, beautiful texts on Christian meditation in this tradition: how long does it take? And he said it takes 'an atom of time'. In other words, it really is in the blink of an eye, it takes no time at all, which is one way of expressing it. The other way of expressing it is, it is endless. We are continually on the journey." -Fr. Laurence Freeman, *Breakthrough*.

If you would like to learn and practice Christian meditation, please join us Wednesdays, 8-8:30 PM as we cultivate our capacity for stillness, as the Psalmist reminds us, "Be still and know God" (Psalm 46:10). In a world (and perhaps even in our church) that often encourages busyness and activity, Scripture reminds us of the importance of taking the time to be still with God.

Eucharistic Miracle of Weiten-Raxendorf, Austria – 1411

In 1411, in the town of Weiten, Austria, a thief broke into the sacristy of a church and stole a consecrated Host. He slipped it into one of his gloves and mounted his horse heading for the village of Spitz.

When he arrived at the spot (that today is marked by a chapel in honor of the miracle) his horse stopped dead in his tracks and refused to move, no matter how much the thief beat him. Nearby some laborers saw what happened and came to help. But there was no way to make the horse move; it stood as still as a statue.

Then without warning, the horse sprung into to a gallop, and the Sacred Host hidden in the thief's glove, dropped to the ground.

A few days later, a woman named Mrs. Scheck passed by the spot and saw the Host encircled in a strong light. Stunned with awe and with great reverence she picked up the Holy Eucharist, and noticed that the consecrated Host was broken in two Parts but remained joined together by threads of Bleeding Flesh.

Out of gratitude, she built a small chapel on the exact spot where she found the miraculous Host. Eventually, a bigger church was needed to accommodate the precious reliquary in order to contain the great crowds that came every year on pilgrimage.

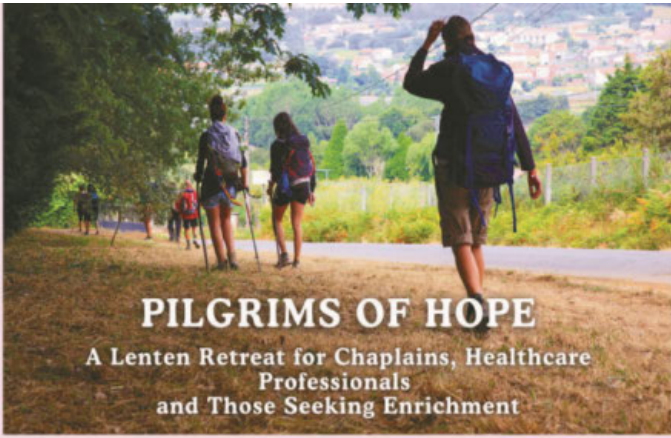

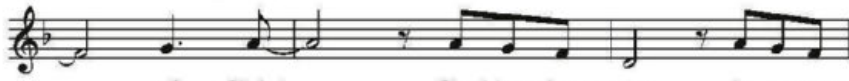
