Message from Fr. Francis

Dear Parish Family,

Today as we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity, we ponder upon one of the deepest mysteries of our faith: One God in Three Persons–Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. And we also honor Father's Day, a moment to give thanks for the fathers, grandfathers, and spiritual fathers who have shaped our lives.

The Trinity is not just a theological puzzle-it is a revelation about who God is: a perfect relationship of love, mutual giving, and unity. Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are not separate individuals doing their own thing. They are united in self-giving love. That love is the heart of God-and it's the heart of who we are created to be.

But we live in a world that often celebrates individualism-telling us that happiness comes from independence, achievement, and self-focus. The Trinity teaches us something radically different:

We become most fully ourselves not when we stand alone, but when we give ourselves in love.

That's why today is the perfect day to honor not only the mystery of God, but also the gift of fatherhood. Good fathers reflect the love of God the Father:

- A love that protects, provides, and forgives.
- A love that sacrifices.
- A love that doesn't seek attention but quietly gives itself day after day.

To all fathers and father-figures: thank you. Your love is one of the clearest signs of God's presence among us.

May we strive to mirror the Trinity in our own lives-choosing relationship over isolation, generosity over self-interest, unity over division. Because wherever we love like God loves, God is present there.

Happy Father's Day-and may the love of the Most Holy Trinity live in all our homes.

CHRISTIAN MEDITATION

"The sacred word is a way of letting go of casual thoughts and of disengaging from the more interesting ones that come down the stream of consciousness. It does this not by attacking thoughts directly but by reaffirming your intention to consent to God's presence and action within. This renewal of the will's consent, as it becomes habitual, creates an atmosphere in which you can simply pay little or no attention to the normal and inevitable flow of thoughts.

If you are nervous about doing what may seem like "nothing" for a period of time, recall that nobody hesitates to go to sleep for six or seven hours every night. Practicing this prayer, however, is not doing nothing. It is a very gentle kind of activity. As long as the will keeps consenting to God by returning to the sacred word when engaged with thoughts, this is enough activity to stay awake and alert." Fr. Thomas Keating, Open Mind, Open Heart.

NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL

Three years ago, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops launched the National Eucharistic Revival, the high point of which was the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis last summer. As the culmination of this three-year initiative, the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will start in Indianapolis on May 18, 2025 and end in Los Angeles. Eight perpetual pilgrims will travel with the Blessed Sacrament across the country, logging 3,340 miles and passing through 20 dioceses.

On Friday, June 20, 2025, the pilgrimage will travel up the coast to Mission Basilica San Buenaventura and then to Sacred Heart Church in Altadena. The next day, Saturday, June 21, it will stop at St. Vincent de Paul Church and end at Mission San Gabriel. Finally, on Sunday, June 22, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels will host the Corpus Christi Celebration, with Mass and a Eucharistic procession through downtown Los Angeles.

ROSARIES AS DECORATIONS

QUESTION:

I've seen people hang rosaries over the rear-view mirrors in their cars and a few of them wear them around their necks. Is it OK to do that?

ANSWER:

The practice of hanging a rosary or a religious medal off of the rearview mirror of one's car is a fairly popular custom across many cultures. While there is no particular rule approving or condemning this practice, we should also be mindful of the respect and reverence due to religious objects and devotional items (i.e. sacramentals).

An important point to consider would be the reason why one chooses to place a rosary or religious medal in our cars. Is it a reminder of the protection and intercession of Mary and the saints? Does it encourage us to be mindful of God's presence, even in such a mundane task as driving? Is it an outward expression of our more private devotions?

One advantage of having a rosary or religious medal in our cars is that it can also serve as a reminder to pray when we travel, asking for protection for ourselves and for other motorists or commuters. Certainly, invoking the protection and prayers of the saints is a wonderful practice for families, helping to reinforce our belief in the communion of saints and the care and concern we owe to one another.

DEVOTIONS *EXPLAINED!* - Connect with Tradition and Grow Your Faith



The Memorare is a prayer to the Blessed Mother in which the supplicant calls upon the maternal love and protection of Mary's intercession in an hour of dire need. "I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my mother," reads one section of the prayer, which goes on to beseech "the Mother of the Word Incarnate" to receive these petitions with love and mercy.

St. Teresa of Calcutta and St. Francis de Sales were two great devotees of this prayer.

Popularized in the 17th century by a French priest named Fr. Claude Bernard, the text is derived from an older and longer prayer entitled "Ad sanctitatis tuae pedes, dulcissima Virgo Maria" ("at your holy feet, most

sweet Virgin Mary"). The title "Memorare" is taken from the Latin word for "remember," which begins the prayer. The modern version appears in the 1846 Raccolta, a collection of indulgenced prayers.


