

## OUR PATRON, SAINT BARNABAS

Barnabas sacrificed himself to be instrumental in God's cultivation of His Church. Paul makes specific mention of the fact that Barnabas, who willingly impoverished himself in the interests of the Church, labored with his own hands to support himself on his missionary journeys. In Acts 4:36, Luke translates Barnabas to mean "son of encouragement" or "son of consolation." The original Greek word rendered "encouragement," *paraklesis*, means encouragement, consolation, comfort, exhortation and entreaty. It may be that the Apostles who gave Joseph the name Barnabas, saw all of these qualities in his character.

## **Gospel Meditation**

## **Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture**

The world is filled with people whose basic needs aren't met, whether for clean water, nutrition, safety, education, meaningful work, stable family life, basic medical resources, religious freedom, and the right to life. So how can we possibly believe what Psalm 145 says to us this week, "The hand of the Lord feeds us, he answers all our needs"? Does he? What about the countless poor? Can't we identify at least a few unmet needs in our own lives right now? Is the Bible promoting wishful thinking and laziness in helping others?

No. The psalm flows from Israel's experience of God's relentless fidelity again and again —especially in the Passover from Egypt. This divine providence is recalled when Jesus feeds the needy multitudes in the Gospel of John. Passover arrives once again, and the people are hungry like the ancient Israelites on the wilderness journey. What is new is that in Jesus God not only provides for their needs, but He learns what it's like to have those human needs. He shares them too. He feeds them bread and fish; and even more, He hungers to provide them, and us, much more than just that kind of perishable food.

Our deepest need is for God. Like the multiplied bread, all earthly provisions ultimately fail, for we all finally die. Of course, our obligation to meet the needs of the poor is basic. But Christ promises to feed us with the one bread that never fails: God Himself. He is humanity's eternal food. If we eat this bread, we taste the faithfulness of God who answers all our needs, even when every earthly thing fails.

BREAD OF LIFE DISCOURSE Gospel of John - Chapter 6

Sundays July 28 - August 25, 2024

For the next five weeks, the Gospel Readings will focus on The Bread of Life Discourse from John's Gospel in Chapter 6. Pay close attention to Jesus' teaching on the Eucharist. We encourage you to pray and reflect on the readings each week using the Eucharistic Gospel Reflection Process.

## **Eucharistic Gospel Reflection Process**

#### TAKE

#### Prayerfully read the Gospel for the coming Sunday

Notice what word or phrase "cuts to the heart" (Acts 2:37) as you listened to the Gospel. What word carries within it God's presence for you?

#### BLESS

Consider how this word/phrase reveals God's goodness, invites you to deeper conversion, or informs or illuminates a missionary moment you've experienced recently.

Share the word/phrase and your connection/reflection.

#### **BREAK**

As you reflect on this passage and your experience, how do you sense God inviting you to be "bread, broken for others" as you live this Eucharistic life united to Jesus, the Bread

Share how you feel called to live this truth.

#### GIVE

Share a resolution based on your reflection and offer a brief prayer asking the Holy Spirit to strengthen you to act on it.

Resolve to make a renewed gift of self for the life of the world.

#### Conclusion: Eucharistic Revival Prayer

Lord Jesus Christ,

you give us your flesh and blood for the life of the world, and you desire that all people come to the Supper of the Sacrifice of the Lamb. Renew in your Church the truth, beauty, and goodness contained in the Most Blessed Eucharist.

Register your child(ren) now for next years' Religious Education sessions:

- If your child is making their First Holy Communion in May 2024, we provide Faith Formation studies for them up to 8<sup>th</sup> grade, which will prepare them and get them ready for the Confirmation program that starts in 9<sup>th</sup> grade. (The cost for Faith Formation is \$100.00.)
- If your child was in their first year of First Holy Communion preparation, they are ready to start their second year of preparation. (The cost for 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Communion is \$175.00.)
- If your child is in 1<sup>st</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> grade, and you are interested in enrolling them in their first-year preparation for First Holy Communion. (The cost for 1<sup>st</sup> Year Communion is \$125.00.)

To keep our prices from increasing for next year's sessions, we are asking that you register your child(ren) early. Early registration is from April 14<sup>th</sup> through June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Please call the Rel. Ed. 


