## OUR PATRON, SAINT BARNABAS

Barnabas sacrificed himself to be instrumental in God's cultivation of His Church. Paul makes specific mention of the fact that Barnabas, who willingly impoverished himself in the interests of the Church, labored with his own hands to support himself on his missionary journeys. In Acts 4:36, Luke translates Barnabas to mean "son of encouragement" or "son of consolation." The original Greek word rendered "encouragement," *paraklesis*, means encouragement, consolation, comfort, exhortation and entreaty. It may be that the Apostles who gave Joseph the name Barnabas, saw all of these qualities in his character.

## Worship & Meditation



You might be asking yourself: Where do I start with inviting someone to take a step closer to Jesus? How might I invite them forward in their faith? Here's a simple four-stage process of accompaniment that focuses on a "heart-to-heart" approach:

1. Identify someone in a spirit of humility
2. Intercede for that person in communion with the Holy Spirit
3. Connect in Eucharistic friendship
4. Invite that person on a path most suitable for him or her

## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Maggots, grubs, worms. When I imagine one or many of these nasty slimy buggers living inside my body — unseen, feeding off my flesh, slowly rotting me out — I feel deeply disgusted. If I knew I had a worm, I would do anything to remove the alien invader, and fast. But what if I couldn't ever get it out?

This is precisely the image Jesus uses to describe those who cause others to sin and fail to cut out what leads them to sin. He contrasts the kingdom of God with Gehenna, "where the worm does not die." If we can stomach it for a moment, there is much wisdom in this nauseating metaphor.

First, sin is always parasitic. It feeds on what is good like a worm in a host. It's not symbiotic or additive, as virtue and love always are. Sin invades, devours, and damages the sinner. Second, sin is always social. No matter how hidden, it quietly eats away at others — usually the most poor and vulnerable, the "little ones," as the Lord says. How healthy it is for us to acknowledge this! Our gossiping, greed, over-indulgence, lying, pride, laziness, lust for power and reputation, and so on ... they do not add anything to life. They are worms eating away at others and ourselves.

We cut out these filthy parasites through genuine repentance and bold action. Imagine the peace and relief that follows the removal of a sickening worm from your body. How much greater is the peace we enjoy when the spiritual worms are gone for good. We'd never wait to act against physical parasites. Neither should we with the worms of sin.

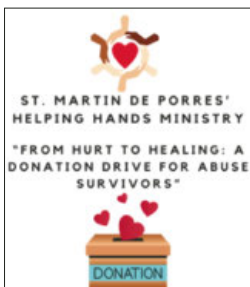
### THE REVIVAL OF OUR MINISTRY

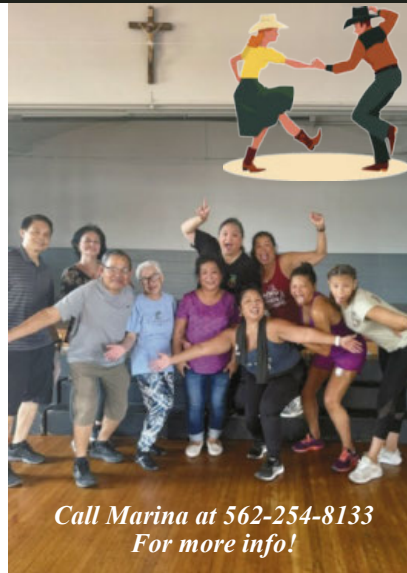

My Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Blessings to you! I pray that you are nourished well by the Holy Eucharist. We are pleased to present the financial position of our Parish for the fiscal year 2023-2024, which covers the period from July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024. The aftermath of Coronavirus pandemic has again posed another challenging year for our parish financial operations.

The Statement of Activities reflects a Net Loss of \$91,713, which is an improvement over last year. Although we embraced a positive trajectory in our finances, we have endured a net loss for the fourth consecutive year.

Due to a slight increase in offertory collections and a withdrawal from our Investment (Savings) Account, we were able to cover all of the Parish operating expenses, including our Archdiocesan Assessment of \$61,330, without asking for monetary support from the Archdiocese. This was made possible due to your generous support, kind sponsors, and anonymous donors. We thank you for your generosity and ask you to prayerfully consider increasing your donations. We invite you to utilize the e-giving option through Faith Direct.

We spent \$56,713 on critical building maintenance and repairs mainly due to roof leaks in the Church, Parish Center, and Rectory which could not be deferred. This was a reduction from the maintenance done in prior year. Due to years of neglect, we still have many Church-improvement projects and other repairs to complete. We plan to begin these with the help of our Called to Renew funds from the Capital Campaign which begun in 2022. We appreciate your commitment to sending your pledge payments to the Called to Renew Capital Campaign. This will help our Parish in a big way.

Our financial operation has been impacted by an increase in insurance, utilities, and property taxes by \$25,579, including a rate adjustment by the city on our sewer/trash rate. The Church and Parish Office had decreased expenses as we closely monitored our spending.

The Balance Sheet presents our cash position; it reflects an operating cash balance of \$63,774 and Investment Funds of \$139,427. Our cash balance was reduced by \$134,123, and our Investment Fund was reduced by \$75,588 in order to meet all of our expenses.

The unfunded Accumulated Archdiocesan Assessment from previous years, has a balance of \$275,751 as of June 30, 2024, and is reflected in the Balance sheet as a Long-Term Liability and an off-set to Equity. We again did not receive an annual credit from the Archdiocese, as in previous years. We are hopeful that the Archdiocese will consider giving us this credit which would reduce or eliminate our debt.

The accumulated debt reflects multiple years of payments owed to the Archdiocese to pay for Parish insurance, Parish pensions, and Archdiocesan Assessments, which were previously unpaid until 2014, prior to my appointment as the Administrator and Pastor to St. Barnabas Parish. We continue to be diligent in our spending, while stabilizing our finances, and working to retire this outstanding debt.

Please know that I deeply appreciate all the sacrifices you make for supporting our Parish. May the Lord reward you with peace and good health. May the Lord bless and strengthen the spiritual and financial well-being of our Parish. Together with the Finance and Pastoral Council, I invoke God's abundant blessings on you and your lovely family!

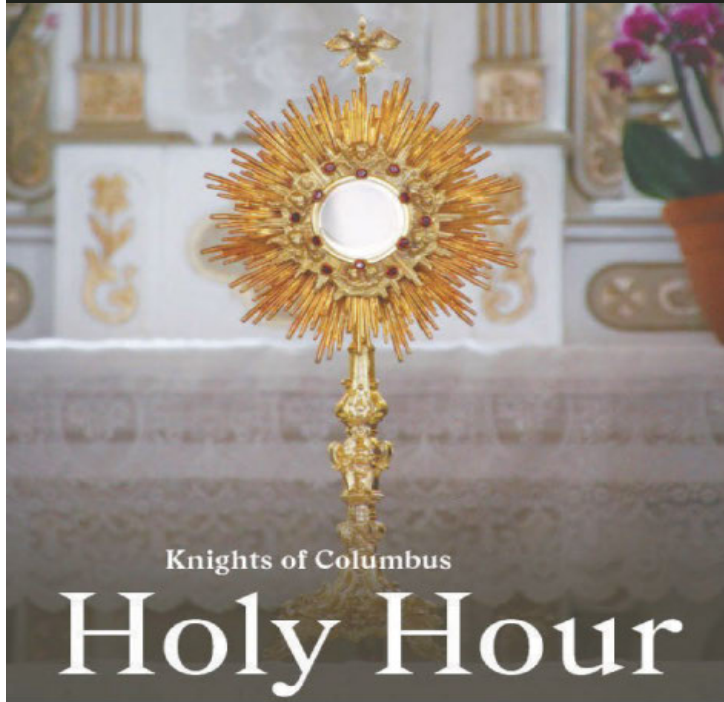

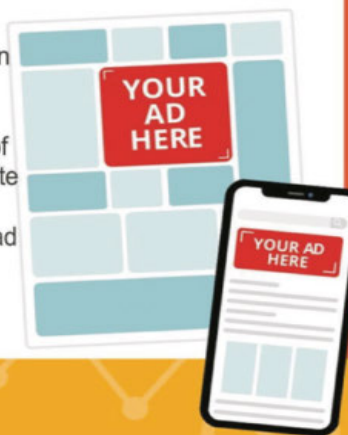

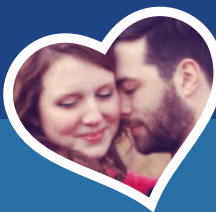
