

OUR PATRON, SAINT BARNABAS

Barnabas sacrificed himself to be instrumental in God's cultivation of His Church. Paul makes specific mention of the fact that Barnabas, who willingly impoverished himself in the interests of the Church, labored with his own hands to support himself on his missionary journeys. In Acts 4:36, Luke translates Barnabas to mean "son of encouragement" or "son of consolation." The original Greek word rendered "encouragement," *paraklesis*, means encouragement, consolation, comfort, exhortation and entreaty. It may be that the Apostles who gave Joseph the name Barnabas, saw all of these qualities in his character.



What Does Love Cost?

Monday of this week is Veterans' Day-a day to honor the generous service of our men and women in uniform who have made personal sacrifices to secure and sustain our cherished freedoms here and abroad. Their example provides an important lesson for all of us, that true freedom always comes at a cost that cannot be measured in monetary terms.

Our culture wants us to believe that freedom means being able to do whatever we want, whenever we want, and as much as we want, free from judgments or limitations imposed by any person, institution, or government policy. But being part of a family-whether at home or in our family of faith-reminds us that our choices have an impact on the lives of those around us, for better or worse.

That is not a bad thing. It helps us to absorb Jesus' parable about the widow who gave her last two coins. Like her, our greatest freedom is found when we give of ourselves abundantly for the benefit of others, even if doing so comes at great personal cost. At its heart, this is a teaching about the nature of God's love. Jesus, the Son of God who literally had everything at his disposal, is the widow who embraced worldly poverty and held nothing back from us out of love.

For most of us, our home life is the setting in which we learn to live and give as Jesus did. There is no amount of wealth that is required to make a loving sacrifice for others. Jesus is our abundance, and his example-brought to life in us through the Holy Spirit-makes it possible for us to freely lay down our lives for others (Jn 15:13), starting at home. Therein lies our greatest happiness. May we be so blessed as to embrace and live a life of love, no matter the cost!

"Marriage based on exclusive and definitive love becomes the icon of the relationship between God and his people and vice versa. God's way of loving becomes the measure of human love." (Pope Benedict XVI, <u>Deus Caritas Est</u>, 11)

ST. FRANCES XAVIER CABRINI

Similarly, St. Frances Xavier Cabrini lived a deeply Eucharistic life. Even as a young child, she showed a great devotion to the Eucharist and desired to adore Christ for all. As an adult, Mother Cabrini dedicated her work to serving Jesus in those around her who were in need. She cared for migrants, housed and looked after orphans, aided the poor, educated children, and tended to the sick, but she was also animated by a deep desire to evangelize and be a messenger of hope to all.

As Pope St. John Paul II said to the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart, St. Cabrini's extraordinary work was a fruit of her prayer, especially before the Blessed Sacrament. Mother Cabrini also encouraged the sisters of her order to do the same as the source of grace for their own work with all those around them in need.



•ST. BARNABAS SCHOOL NEWS STUDENT NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY




