

OUR PATRON, SAINT BARNABAS

Barnabas sacrificed himself to be instrumental in God's cultivation of His Church. Paul makes specific mention of the fact that Barnabas, who willingly impoverished himself in the interests of the Church, labored with his own hands to support himself on his missionary journeys. In Acts 4:36, Luke translates Barnabas to mean "son of encouragement" or "son of consolation." The original Greek word rendered "encouragement," *paraklesis*, means encouragement, consolation, comfort, exhortation and entreaty. It may be that the Apostles who gave Joseph the name Barnabas, saw all of these qualities in his character.

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

I recently moved into a new neighborhood. On my first evening I went grocery shopping and could not find my usual favorite Greek yogurt. Strangely, my heart started to race. All the losses of my previous life hit me. So many of my old friends, habits, comforts, and predictable experiences had fallen away. There I stood, a grown man, crying like a little boy whose world was falling apart in the dairy aisle.

This week, Jesus describes what to do when one world ends, and another begins. Does it apply to the end of time? Yes. Does it apply to the end of our individual lives? Yes. It also applies to every "world" we inhabit throughout our lives, in school, family, friendships, work, play and so on. First, the sun, moon, and stars fall. The old, familiar ways of running things suddenly stop working. Light fades. Things fall apart. It's awful. But, second, Christ comes "in the clouds." Jesus, the Son of Man, replaces those old powers with himself as the prime governing principle. Third, he sends out his angels to "gather his elect from the four winds." He re-integrates the fragments into a new integrated whole. "Summer is near," he concludes. A new world begins.

Is your world crumbling? Are your sun, moon, and stars falling from the sky? Learn to discern the pattern of the Cross and Resurrection at work in it. This is the power we touch in the Mass. Jesus is coming precisely in this transition from the old to the new world. It doesn't make our losses easy. But it does make it possible to glimpse the dawning of a summer, a new beginning, the life of the world to come.

"Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope, but do it with gentleness and reverence..." (1 Peter 3:15-16).

How to prepare and give a testimony:

- When preparing, ask the Holy Spirit to guide you in sharing the most important truths of your story. Believe that God will empower you through His Spirit to be his witness, as he promised.
- Remember, your testimony is a personal story of faith and transformation.
 Be authentic, and focus on how Christ has impacted your life. This story is ultimately about Him, so ensure that you are authentically sharing about God's actions.
- 3. Your story does not have to be about an unhappy or distressing time in your faith journey. Your testimony could be anything. It could refer to the birth of a child, an encounter with God through a joyful encounter with a stranger, etc.
- In your testimony, avoid criticizing or judging others. Instead, use words that give hope and meaning to your listeners, sharing with them the goodness of life in God



Someone in your life is longing for a relationship with Jesus—even if they don't know it yet. And Jesus is calling you to reach out to them. Whether they're questioning, hurting, or simply in need of a listening ear, Christ wants to work through you to bring them to an encounter that will transform their life.

Listen to their story, and <u>share your</u> <u>own</u>. One conversation could be the beginning of their journey home.





•ST. BARNABAS SCHOOL NEWS STUDENT NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY




