

OUR PATRON, SAINT BARNABAS

Barnabas sacrificed himself to be instrumental in God's cultivation of His Church. Paul makes specific mention of the fact that Barnabas, who willingly impoverished himself in the interests of the Church, labored with his own hands to support himself on his missionary journeys. In Acts 4:36, Luke translates Barnabas to mean "son of encouragement" or "son of consolation." The original Greek word rendered "encouragement," *paraklesis*, means encouragement, consolation, comfort, exhortation and entreaty. It may be that the Apostles who gave Joseph the name Barnabas, saw all of these qualities in his character.



Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

I eat breakfast. If I don't have something substantial, I'm fading by midmorning. Breakfast is my key meal because it sets up my physical wellbeing for the rest of the day.

Spiritually speaking, we need sustenance to get us going. This is true for the Apostles in this Sunday's remarkable Gospel reading. The risen Jesus makes his third appearance to them in the early morning light and calls, "Come, have breakfast" (John 21:12). The exhausted and cold fishermen sit, and he feeds them bread and fish as the dawn breaks. They are overwhelmed by his presence to the point of awestruck silence. As they eat, their bodies and their hearts come alive. Once refreshed by their morning meal, they will be ready to feed others — indeed, the whole world — with the love of the risen Jesus. But first, they need breakfast from him.

Do you realize how essential early morning prayer is? Jesus desires to refresh us every morning with his word of love, with his grace-filled presence. This week, hear Jesus calling to you: "Come, have breakfast!" Embrace some form of spiritual, meditative practice each morning for spiritual strength to get you going.

What is a Eucharistic Missionary?

Eucharistic Missionaries will be a big part of the Year of Mission! Inspired by encounters with Christ in the Eucharist and fueled by the Bread of Life, we will become powerful instruments of his grace "for the life of the world."

- <u>Eucharistic Encounter</u>: A Eucharistic Missionary engages in regular encounters with Jesus in the Eucharist through a weekly holy hour and, where possible, one weekday Mass in addition to their Sunday obligation. They offer up this additional Mass for ongoing Eucharistic Revival in the United States.
- 2. <u>Eucharistic Identity</u>: A Eucharistic Missionary continually forms their identity in Jesus Christ through ongoing spiritual formation, education, and service to their parish and community, especially those on the peripheries. The National Eucharistic Congress provides resources and formation materials for Eucharistic Missionaries. This formation includes an annual period prior to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.
- <u>Eucharistic Life</u>: A Eucharistic Missionary is grounded in their family, neighborhood, and parish and is both nourished by this community and a contributor to this community. They form intentional relationships with those closest to them, stepping out of themselves to truly love their neighbors.
- 4. <u>Eucharistic Mission</u>: A Eucharistic Missionary desires to give what they have been given by Jesus. This Eucharistic Mission is sustained by periods of fasting and almsgiving, and is lived out explicitly by a Eucharistic Missionary walking with one person in his or her journey of faith.






