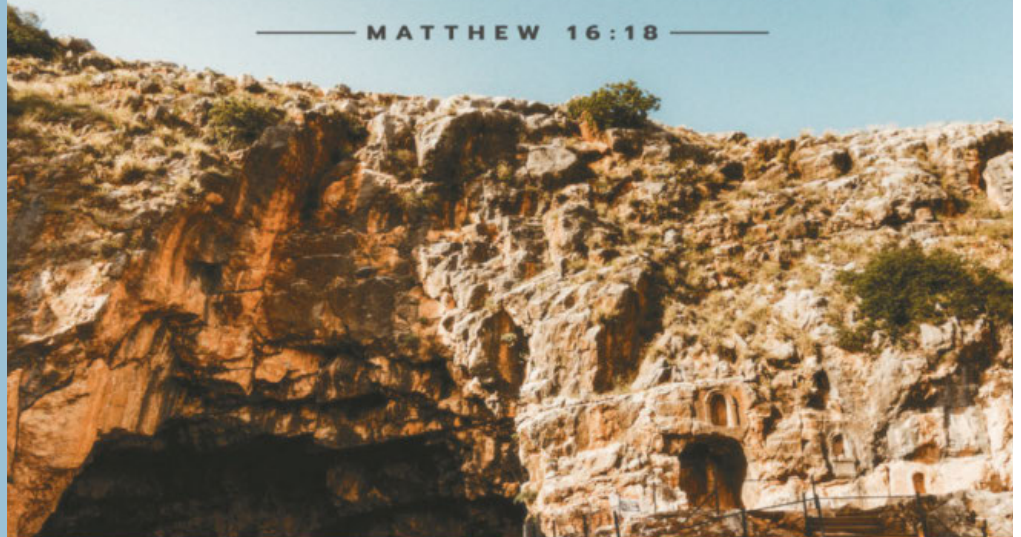

## OUR PATRON, SAINT BARNABAS (Feast Day: June 11)

Barnabas sacrificed himself to be instrumental in God's cultivation of His Church. Paul makes specific mention of the fact that Barnabas, who willingly impoverished himself in the interests of the Church, labored with his own hands to support himself on his missionary journeys. In Acts 4:36, Luke translates Barnabas to mean "son of encouragement" or "son of consolation." The original Greek word rendered "encouragement," *paraklesis*, means encouragement, consolation, comfort, exhortation and entreaty. It may be that the Apostles who gave Joseph the name Barnabas, saw all of these qualities in his character.

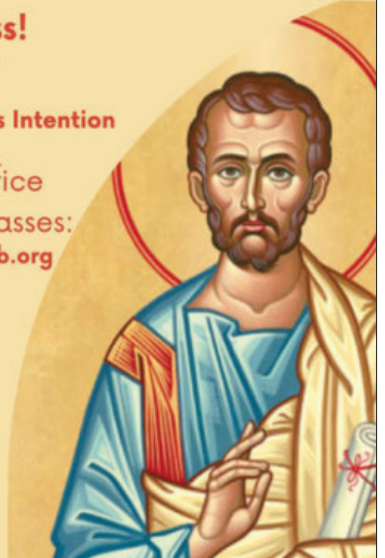

## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

What do you call brothers who are born on the same day? Twins, of course. That is what we celebrate today in the inestimable saints, Peter and Paul. Wait: twins? Yes. The early Church believed that Peter and Paul were martyred in Rome on the same day. Since the day of martyrdom is celebrated as a saints' birth into eternal life, the result is striking: Peter and Paul are twins in God's family, the Church.

Who should care about this? Well, anyone who longs to live in a world marked by love and peace. Remember, the Romans believed that twins, Romulus and Remus, founded their city through an act of fratricide, the former murdering the latter. Sadly, the structures of this fallen world emerge through violence between those who should love each other. But in the Church, a new city has been founded upon this new set of twins, embodying the non-violent power of Jesus' cross and resurrection.

That's why traditional icons represent Peter and Paul in a fraternal and warm embrace. Contrasted with the violence of Rome's founders, it challenges us with a bold claim: do we believe that structures of merciful love are more powerful and lasting than those based on power, violence, and domination? Am I willing to see others in my life as my "twin," with whom I am called to give my life for Christ, or as my rival? Am I committed to living what is embodied in Romulus and Remus, or in Peter and Paul?

The first of its kind National Eucharistic Pilgrimage landed at the 10<sup>th</sup> National Eucharistic Congress, kicking off a year dedicated to propelling our Church into a new chapter of faith and mission. That chapter will continue unfolding through our Eucharistic Missionaries.



As the official three year **National Eucharistic Revival** comes to a close, it's important to 1) reflect back on the graces that God has given us through this movement, and 2) realize that the work has really just begun...

As we've said all along, revival is not something we can manufacture. It's the work of God, stirring within one's heart. Revival, therefore, is the ongoing work of a lifetime -- of cooperating with God's work in our lives moment to moment, day to day, and year to year. This movement has simply been the launching pad for that process.

So. Are we excited the official revival is coming to a close? **Absolutely.** But are we going anywhere? **No.** Not until every Catholic has a living relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist.

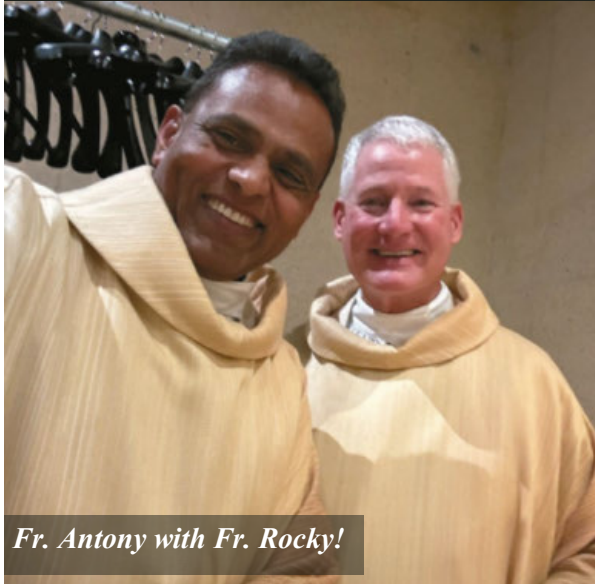

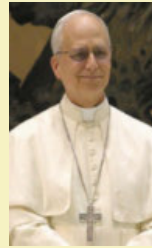

Dear St. Barnabas, Religious Education Parents:

Register your child(ren) now for next years' Religious Education sessions:

- If your child is making their First Holy Communion in May 2025, we provide Faith Formation studies for them up to 8<sup>th</sup> grade, which will prepare them and get them ready for the Confirmation program that starts in 9<sup>th</sup> grade. (The cost for Faith Formation is \$100.00.)
- If your child is in their first year of First Holy Communion preparation, they are ready to start their second year of preparation. (The cost for 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Communion is \$175.00.)
- If your child is in 1<sup>st</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> grade, and you are interested in enrolling them in their first-year preparation for First Holy Communion. (The cost for 1<sup>st</sup> Year Communion is \$125.00.)

To keep our prices from increasing for next year's sessions, we are asking that you register your child(ren) early. Early registration is from now through June 30, 2025. Please call the Rel. Ed. Office at (562) 988-6855 for more information or to set up an appointment, or go on the church's website at [church@stbarnabaslb.org](mailto:church@stbarnabaslb.org) to sign up. There will be a \$25.00 late fee applied to the prices above for all registrations after June 30, 2025. That being said, we do offer family discounts.

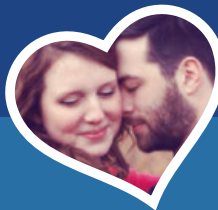
