FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Happy Feast Day Everyone!

This weekend we celebrate our patronal feast day of the Holy Family and, though this is not the time chosen for the parish fiesta, it is a good opportunity to revisit why this commemoration is vital to our understanding of who we are as a parish. As we gather to honor the family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, we are directed to pattern our own families to them. It is not the "perfect" human family shielded from suffering, confusion, and mishaps. The Gospels made it clear that this family underwent a few unpleasant adventures, stemming from external reasons (Herod wanted to kill the child) and a few judgment errors of the parents (Jesus was lost in Jerusalem during a pilgrimage). I am sure many of us can relate to that. Nonetheless, this family is our model of holiness. It is a family that is made up of selfless individuals who are willing to make sacrifices for each other.

Last December 17th, I celebrated a Misa De Gallo (the early morning variation of the Christmas novena Masses similar to our practice) at the Our Lady of the Assumption Church in Claremont. The thirty-plus-mile trip to that church from Artesia was not easy. I was grateful that traveling to that corner of the county was not a regular part of my daily commute. After the celebration, one of the attendees approached me and introduced himself as the grandson of Nancy Torres, the late choir director of our De Colores Choir whose voices animate our earliest Mass on Sundays. This church in Claremont was her home parish, and she practically lived in the neighborhood. Then it just dawned on me that my lengthy but rare drive to this northeastern edge of the Archdiocese was a poor comparison compared to Nancy's regular journey to Artesia to lead the choir and to rehearse them as well. That she did this for about thirty years is no less astounding. Yet, this is not a unique story. We have more parishioners with different narratives but they share in the common thread of selfless giving to their church-family at Holy Family.

As companions in this pilgrimage of life, this example of the Holy Family—complemented by the selflessness lived by many of our past and present volunteers—serves as our beacon that points to how we can make our circle of relationships holy. It starts with a nurturing spirit that is willing to make sacrifices for the greater good. Our church family, though imperfect, has been a vibrant faith community because we have loving parishioners who are not only generous with their time but also willing to expand the horizon of their service through specialized courses such as liturgy, music, scriptures, photography, catechetics, mental health services, and spirituality. To these vital members of the parish, thank you for taking these positive steps in building up our family, the body of Christ, in wonderful ways. As we start a new year, I am encouraging these initiatives for the greater glory of God.

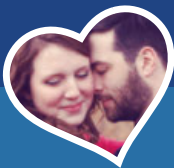
