FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Saint Peter, in the opening line of his first letter, addresses his readers as sojourners—pilgrims. On this Easter Sunday, the phrase coined by his 265th successor for the current Jubilee Year rings with a special significance for we are all called to be “pilgrims of hope.”

One of the things that characterize the journey of each traveler in a strange land is that the road is uncertain. We cannot predict what the road will be. In her 2000-year journey, the pilgrim church

of Christ has gone through dizzying stages of suffering, death, triumph, and then suffering once more; it has been a repeating process that mirrors the famous words in the opening narration of ABC's Wide World of Sports that have been etched in my mind since I was a child: “the thrill of victory and the agony of defeat.” The uncertain twists and turns of the pilgrimage of life—like all of world history— are beyond our control. Yet, God never allows us to be utterly helpless. He has instilled in our hearts the capacity to respond well to life's surprises. This grace is not just for our benefit, but also for those who accompany us in our journey.

This gift is hope. I speak of hope in an era of uncertainty and disheartening news, be it in the world, the church, and possibly even in our journeys. Yet, this pall of darkness is not unique to this moment. This is not the only time when believing grows wearisome and loving becomes a burden. In the times when it is difficult to get up from bed, I remember the words written in 2002 by this brilliant preacher for the popes, the Capuchin friar (and now Cardinal) Rainero Cantalamessa, describing hope as the little sister of faith and love which pulls them both forward. Pope Francis, at the beginning of *Spes non confundit*, described hope as both a desire and expectation of good things in the face of uncertainty. We do not simply believe in the resurrection; with unflinching hope, we expect life beyond our disheartening experiences of death. We do not simply love God and neighbor; with fierce hope, we burn with desire and enthusiasm to fulfill the greatest of commandments even amid discouragement. Hope, that feisty little sister, can truly pack a punch!

Looking at the Regina Coeli, the Easter version of the Angelus, we find traces of this unwavering hope. We do not only say that Jesus “Has risen as he said, alleluia;” we insist: *Quia surrexit Dominus vere, alleluia*—For the Lord HAS TRULY RISEN, alleluia. As pilgrims of hope, we must join the chorus of the faithful that declares this profound truth at the very core of our being because we journey together in this pilgrimage and there will always be a need for encouragement. The Lord has truly risen, and death no longer has the final word in the conversation; our earthly pilgrimage does not end at Calvary! Happy Easter everyone and may hope always lead the way!

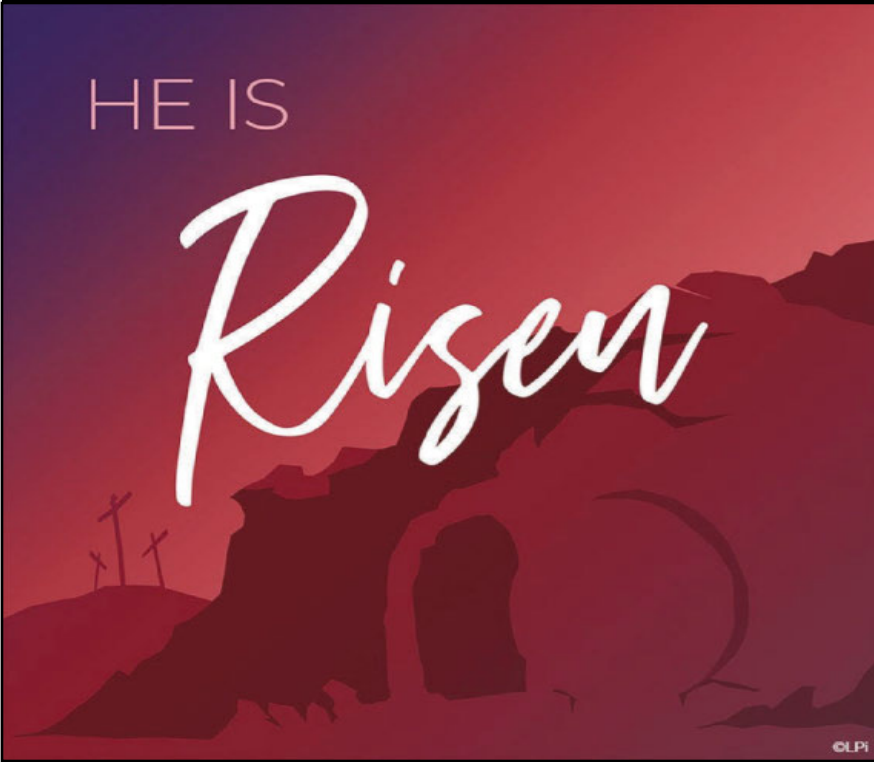

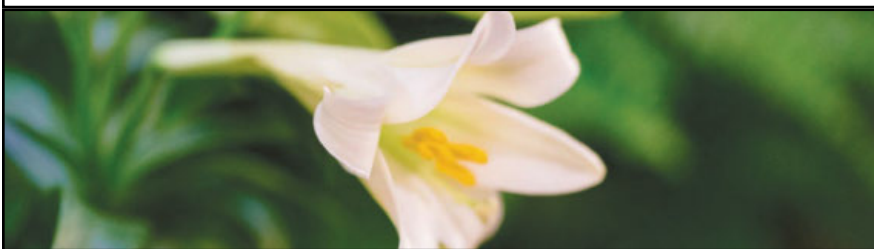

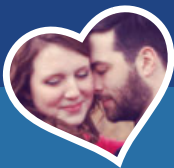
