PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners,

September 24: Anniversary of the Dedication of Holy Family Church

A Catholic parish is established by the decree of the bishop of the diocese, designating a portion of the diocese (not only the territory but the people who live there) to the care of a parish priest, who is often named the pastor of the parish. Associate pastors are sometimes assigned to a parish to assist the pastor with the care of souls. The parish also exists as a legal entity in Church law that designates a particular community of the People of God. One of the major milestones for a parish community is the construction of the parish church: the sacred place where we worship God together, hear his saving Word, celebrate the Sacraments, especially the Eucharist, and express our Catholic Faith in public as a witness of how God's mercy is saving and transforming our life and the world.

With Fr. Joseph Shea in 2007, we celebrated the 100th anniversary of the legal establishment of Holy Family as a parish. But the founding generation of parishioners only completed the construction of the current building in 1921. At that time, Los Angeles was part of the Diocese of Los Angeles-San Diego. Only in 1936 was Los Angeles named an Archdiocese. On September 24, 1922, Bishop John Joseph Cantwell blessed and dedicated the church building in which we now worship God. We keep the anniversary of this date as a celebration of our particular community of the People of God in Glendale. The church building is not simply a gathering space, but rather a visible sign of the Church (the People of God) living in this place, a visible sign of the dwelling that God has made among human beings who have been reconciled and united in Christ. It is an extension of the Incarnation of Christ. Jesus continues to be present not only spiritually but physically among us: in our bodies that are Temples of the Holy Spirit, in the Sacraments (especially the Holy Eucharist) that incorporate the elements of creation to give us God's grace, in the Christian family as the domestic Church (the Church in the home), and in the sacred buildings that are dignified and made beautiful for divine worship by applying our artistic gifts in response to God's goodness and beauty.

Each year, September 24 is celebrated at Holy Family as the anniversary of the dedication of our church and is celebrated as a Solemnity, which allows it to replace a Sunday in Ordinary Time. Last year, my first year here, I only came to know about the anniversary two weeks before the date. Although it was the 100th anniversary, we did not have time to publicize it and when I celebrated the Solemnity last year, there was some confusion among parishioners between the legal establishment of the parish (1907) and the dedication of the church (1922). This year is the 101st anniversary of this visible church that was built through the love and sacrifices of our ancestors in faith, and renovated and beautified through your love and sacrifices in recent years. And it has been entrusted to our care so that, united in the same faith that inspired them, we may press forward on the same earthly pilgrimage to our heavenly homeland, strengthened by the confidence that God's Kingdom is already here and is being brought to completion not only in the wood and stone of visible buildings, but in our flesh and blood and spirit.

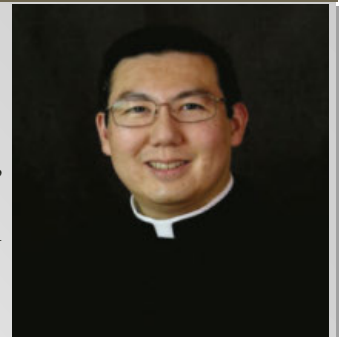

Queridos feligreses,

24 de septiembre: Aniversario de la dedicación de la Iglesia (Templo) de la Sagrada Familia

Una parroquia católica se establece por decreto del obispo de la diócesis, designando una porción de la diócesis (no sólo el territorio sino la gente que vive allí) al cuidado de un sacerdote, que a menudo es nombrado el párroco de la parroquia. A veces se asignan párrocos asociados a una parroquia para ayudar al párroco en la cura de almas (la cura pastoral). La parroquia también existe como entidad jurídica en el derecho de la Iglesia que designa a una comunidad particular del Pueblo de Dios. Uno de los principales hitos de una comunidad parroquial es la construcción del templo parroquial: el lugar sagrado donde adoramos juntos a Dios,

escuchamos su Palabra salvadora, celebramos los Sacramentos, especialmente la Eucaristía, y expresamos nuestra Fe Católica en público como testimonio de cómo la misericordia de Dios salva y transforma nuestra vida y el mundo.



Con el P. Joseph Shea en 2007, celebramos el centenario del establecimiento legal de la parroquia de la Sagrada Familia. Pero la generación fundadora de feligreses no terminó la construcción del templo actual hasta 1921. En aquella época, Los Ángeles formaba parte de la diócesis de Los Ángeles-San Diego. Sólo en 1936 Los Ángeles fue nombrada Archidiócesis. El 24 de septiembre de 1922, el Obispo Monseñor John Joseph Cantwell bendijo y dedicó el templo en el que ahora adoramos a Dios. Mantenemos el aniversario de esta fecha como una celebración de nuestra comunidad particular del Pueblo de Dios en Glendale. El templo no es simplemente un espacio de reunión, sino más bien un signo visible de la Iglesia (el Pueblo de Dios) que vive en este lugar, un signo visible de la morada que Dios ha hecho entre los seres humanos que han sido reconciliados y unidos en Cristo. Es una prolongación de la Encarnación de Cristo. Jesús sigue estando presente no sólo espiritualmente sino físicamente entre nosotros: en nuestros cuerpos que son Templos del Espíritu Santo, en los Sacramentos (especialmente la Sagrada Eucaristía) que incorporan los elementos de la creación para darnos la gracia de Dios, en la familia cristiana como Iglesia doméstica (la Iglesia en el hogar), y en los edificios sagrados que se dignifican y embellecen para el culto divino aplicando nuestros dones artísticos en respuesta a la bondad y belleza de Dios.

Cada año, el 24 de septiembre se celebra en nuestra parroquia de la Sagrada Familia el aniversario de la dedicación del templo y se celebra como Solemnidad, lo que permite sustituir un domingo del Tiempo Ordinario. El año pasado, mi primer año aquí, sólo me enteré del aniversario dos semanas antes de la fecha. Aunque era el centenario, no tuvimos tiempo de darle publicidad y, cuando celebré la solemnidad el año pasado, hubo confusión entre los feligreses entre el establecimiento legal de la parroquia (1907) y la dedicación del templo (1922). Este año se cumple el 101° aniversario de esta iglesia visible que fue construida gracias al amor y los sacrificios de nuestros antepasados en la fe, y renovada y embellecida gracias al amor y sacrificios de ustedes en años recientes. Y ha sido confiada a nuestro cuidado para que, unidos en la misma fe que los inspiró, sigamos adelante en la misma peregrinación terrenal hacia nuestra patria celestial, fortalecidos por la confianza de que el Reino de Dios ya está aquí y se está completando no sólo en la madera y la piedra de los edificios visibles, sino en nuestra carne y sangre y espíritu.
