



It's almost time to bring your palms from last year. The dried palm branches will be burned to make the ashes for this year's Ash Wednesday services.

Baskets will be in the vestibule and north entrance of the church beginning next Saturday, February 3. You may also drop them off at the Parish office.



The Catholic Archdiocese of Los Angeles has provided a religious presence to Los Angeles County Hospital since 1876, with the Daughters of Charity and the clergy from Sacred Heart parish. In 1889 the Archdiocese began to provide chaplains to Los Angeles General Hospital. The original, 100-bed county hospital was built in 1878 and became affiliated with the USC School of Medicine in 1885. Priests from the three nearby parishes — Sacred Heart Church (1889-), Santa Teresita (1923-), Saint Brigeta (1940?-) — all provided Catholic chaplain priests for the patients' needs.

In 1954, Saint Camillus Parish was founded and since that time has provided Catholic chaplains to LAC+USC Medical Center. In 1985 and under the vision of then pastor Fr. Don Kribs, the parish boundaries were reworked and it became Saint Camillus Center for Pastoral Care. The chaplains' fulltime focus became the Los Angeles County-USC Medical Center, USC/Norris Comprehensive Cancer Center & Hospital, and USC University Hospital.

Today, St. Camillus Center for Spiritual Care continues to provide 24-hour ministry to this community.



WHAT? WHO? WHERE? WHEN?

There is so much that happens during the Mass that we may not understand or even notice. Coming to Mass is a very important part of our journey of faith because it keeps us connected to Jesus and it reminds us that we are part of a community of believers: our family in Christ! Here are more ways we can be mindful as we bring young children and youth to celebrate Mass, and maybe even some hints for us as adults.

Adapted from 77 Ways to Pray with your Kids.

Unpack the Mass. After Mass is over, talk about what you just experienced. If you didn't discuss the Scriptures in advance, discuss them on the way home, along with elements of the liturgy that seemed striking. What did you see? What did you hear?

Introduce your family the priest, lectors, musicians, and servers. If your parish sponsors a social hour after Mass, (yes, donuts and coffee by the auditorium) be sure you get to know the priest and liturgical ministers. Recognizing these people as they celebrate the Mass will increase participation and engagement.

QUÉ? QUIÉN? DÓNDE? CUÁNDO?

Suceden tantas cosas durante la Misa que es posible que no entendamos o ni siquiera nos demos cuenta. Venir a Misa es una parte muy importante de nuestro camino de fe porque nos mantiene conectados con Jesús y nos recuerda que somos parte de una comunidad de creyentes: ¡nuestra familia en Cristo! Aquí hay más formas en las que podemos ser conscientes al llevar a niños pequeños y jóvenes a celebrar la Misa, y tal vez incluso algunos consejos para nosotros como adultos.

Miren más profundamente la Misa. Después de terminar la Misa, hablen sobre lo que acaba de experimentar. Si no discutieron las Escrituras con anticipación, hablen de ellas en el camino a casa, junto con los elementos de la liturgia que les parecieron sorprendentes. ¿Qué viste? ¿Qué escuchaste?

Presente a su familia al sacerdote, los lectores, los músicos y los servidores. Si su parroquia patrocina una hora social después de la Misa (sí se hace, hay donas y café junto al auditorio), asegúrese de conocer al sacerdote y a los ministros litúrgicos. Reconocer a estas personas mientras celebran la Misa aumentará la participación y el compromiso.
