EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL PRAYER

Archbishop José Gomez June 1, 2022

We Welcomed St. Jude

We were honored to host the relic of St. Jude last Monday. We had over 3,000 pilgrims come through the church to venerate the relic with over 600 attending the Mass. Fr. Carlos Martins' homily gave so much history and knowledge about this amazing Saint that many of us did not know. Thank you to the many wonderful volunteers who helped with setup, cleanup and in making sure the day ran smoothly, our clergy and liturgical ministers who served at Mass and to the staff who worked tirelessly to get everything ready for the day .



The Acta: "In the year of our salvation 2019, on the 10th day of the month of August, I, Jose H. Gomez, Archbishop of Los Angeles, dedicated this church in honor of Our Lady of the Assumption and placed in the altar the relics of Saints and Martyrs Thomas Becket, Clare of Assisi, Raymond Nonnatus, Paschal Baylon, Felix of Cantalice, Leonard, and Roch. Furthermore, I am granting a plenary indulgence to the individual Christian faithful present today, as well as to those who visit this church on the anniversary of its dedication, according to the norms of the Enchiridion indulgentiarum, 1999."



St. Thomas Becket (b.1118-d.1170) As Archbishop of Canterbury, England, he defended the Church against King Henry II who sought control over the clergy and weakened ties to Rome. He was murdered at Canterbury Cathedral by the king's henchmen. His tomb has been the popular site of pilgrimage over the centuries. His feast is Dec. 29.

St. Clare of Assisi (b.1194-d.1253) was one of the first followers of St. Francis. She was born into the nobility in Italy, but (like Francis) renounced a comfortable life and served the poor and sick. She was joined by others and founded a women's order. As abbess, she was the advisor to popes and cardinals. Her feast is Aug. 11.



St. Raymond Nonnatus (b.1204-d.1240) is a Spanish saint who is patron of childbirth, midwives, children, pregnant women and priests defending the confidentiality of confession. After ordination, he ransomed Christian captives in North Africa, and became captive himself. His feast is Aug. 31.

St. Paschal Baylon (b.1540-d.1592) was a humble shepherd in Spain who became a Franciscan brother known for his compassion toward the sick, and his deep devotion to the Eucharist. His feast is May 17.



St. Leonard (b.1676-d.1751) was a Franciscan writer and humble preacher who was famous for his missions for spiritual renewal attended by thousands. He promoted devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Stations of the Cross, and Eucharistic Adoration. His feast is Nov. 27.

St. Felix of Cantalice (b.1515-d.1587) learned to pray while working as a shepherd. He became a Franciscan brother and street evangelist, and he taught catechism to children through song. His feast is May 18.



St. Roch or Rocco (b.1348-d.1376?) is the patron saint of dogs, epidemics, and knee problems. He is claimed by the Third Order Franciscans. His feast is Aug. 16.



First Reading

We hear the Israelites' enthusiastic commitment to the covenant at Mount Sinai with their words: "We will do everything that the Lord has told us." What are you passionately committed to in your life? (Ex 24:3-8)

Second Reading

Hebrews teaches us that through his death (Jesus's blood), believers receive the promised eternal inheritance. How often do you think about "eternity?" (Heb 9:11-15)

Gospel Reading

Jesus taught his disciples that through his death, his body and blood would be shed for many. How should we show gratitude for such a sacrifice? (Mk 14:12-16, 22-26)

Jesus is the Passover Lamb come to fulfillment, and his sacrifice washes our hearts in the blood of the new covenant. He is passing us the cup of salvation. Let us take it and call on the name of the Lord.

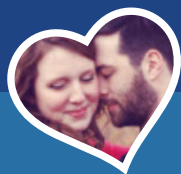

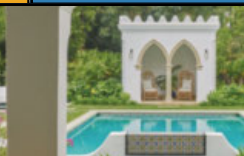
