Message FROM THE Pastor



Dear St. John Eudes family,

I remember when I was a young boy and my family and I took a vacation to the Smokey Mountains in North Carolina. During that trip we had many great adventures, hikes, and experiences, one of which included panning for gold. As we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration today, I am reminded of that experience in particular.

When you pan for gold, you are given an allotment of dirt to sift through. You bring that portion of dirt over to a trough which is fed by running water. As you sift the tray of dirt through the water, the dirt is washed away down the trough and any minerals that were contained within are caught by the screen to be collected.

I don't really remember if any of us found gold or any other precious minerals, but the excitement and hope of finding something valuable and sharing that experience with my family was the real treasure.

Jesus guarantees us that there is a hidden treasure within each of us; he bet his life on it. As the first born of many brothers and sisters, Jesus reveals to us, in the Transfiguration, the glory of God hidden within.

St. Paul assures us that we too carry this treasure within us, even if in earthen vessels (2 Cor 4:7). The paschal mystery, the suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension of Christ, is the fresh running water which sifts through all of the dirt that covers and hides this treasure, the glory of God.

The hidden treasure is truly within each of us, in our own selves, our neighbors, and even in those that we can not stand, the really filthy ones completely covered in dirt!!

May the feast of the Transfiguration of Christ, reveal the hidden glory of God for the whole world to see.
