Pastor's Message

"Over the next few weeks, the bulletin will present portions of a Pastoral Letter written by Fr. Earthman, entitled *O Sacrum Convivium / O Sacred Banquet*."

31. During the history of the Church, Christians longed to look upon the Lord with their own eyes, particularly during one of the elevations during the Mass. These elevations were introduced into the Mass only as late as the 13th Century, when bishops asked the priest to lift up the Sacred Host after the Words of Institution so that the Faithful could look upon the Lord in the Sacrament during the Eucharistic Prayer. Some late medieval accounts describe the piety of the faithful desiring to view the Consecrated Host as "going to see my Maker." Indeed, the practice of ringing bells during these elevations began as a reminder to the Faithful that the Lord is Present and that they are invited to "look upon the one whom they have pierced" (Cf. Jn 19:37).

32. Paradoxically, as reception of Holy Communion by the Faithful at Mass dwindled in the late Middle Ages, Eucharistic devotions increased. This led to a kind of an "extension" of the elevation of the Sacred Host at Mass, whereby our Eucharistic Lord was placed inside a large, circular metal container with a window whereby the Faithful could view the Eucharist for longer periods of time. This large, round container is called a monstrance, deriving from the Latin verb *monstrare*, meaning broadly "to show in order that others might see." Thus, our large, round metal monstrance is the principal way in which our Eucharistic Lord is shown to us that we might not only see, but *believe* that he is Truly, Really, Sacramentally Present in the Eucharist (Cf. Jn 20:29).

33. When we adore our Eucharistic Lord, we "should remember that this presence derives from the Sacrifice [of the Mass] and tends toward sacramental and spiritual communion." Indeed, as we adore our Lord, we should offer prayers of thanksgiving, praise, and adoration. We should pray for our family, our parish, and our world. It is also praiseworthy that we read from the Bible and are fed by the Word of God as we adore the Word of God, now present in the Sacrament of the Eucharist.

34. Indeed, in order to make better distinctions about the kind of prayer we are doing in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, we need to define two terms: (1) adoration and (2) exposition.

35. *Adoration* is defined in the Catechism of the Catholic Church as "the first act of the virtue of religion. To adore God is to acknowledge him as God, as the Creator and Savior, the Lord and Master of everything that exists, as infinite and merciful Love. 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve,' says Jesus, citing Deuteronomy." When we adore God, we are acknowledging him as our Lord, recognizing his omnipotent divinity in the face of our own limited humanity. We can make acts of adoration apart from visits to the Blessed Sacrament (as in times of private prayer). However, when we are in the presence of the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament – solemnly reserved in the tabernacle – we can also adore the sacred Body of our Eucharistic Lord, who is Sacramentally present in our midst. This is adoration.

Mensaje del Párroco

“En las próximas semanas, el boletín presentará fragmentos de una Carta Pastoral escrita por el P. Earthman, titulada O Sacrum Convivium / Oh Sagrado Banquete”.

31. Durante la historia de la Iglesia, los cristianos anhelaban mirar al Señor con sus propios ojos, especialmente durante una de las elevaciones durante la Misa. Estas elevaciones se introdujeron en la Misa solo en el siglo XIII, cuando los obispos pidieron al sacerdote que levantara la Sagrada Hostia después de las Palabras de Institución para que los fieles pudieran mirar al Señor en el Sacramento durante la Plegaria Eucarística. Algunos relatos medievales tardíos describen la piedad de los fieles que deseaban ver la Hostia Consagrada como "ir a ver a mi Hacedor". De hecho, la práctica de tocar las campanas durante estas elevaciones comenzó como un recordatorio a los fieles de que el Señor está presente y que están invitados a «mirar a aquel a quien traspasaron» (cf. Jn 19, 37).

32. Paradójicamente, a medida que disminuía la recepción de la sagrada Comunión por parte de los fieles en la Misa a finales de la Edad Media, aumentaban las devociones eucarísticas. Esto llevó a una especie de "extensión" de la elevación de la Sagrada Hostia en la Misa, por la cual nuestro Señor Eucarístico fue colocado dentro de un gran recipiente metálico circular con una ventana por la cual los fieles podían ver la Eucaristía durante períodos de tiempo más largos. Este recipiente grande y redondo se llama custodia, que deriva del verbo latino *monstrare*, que significa en términos generales "mostrar para que otros puedan ver". Por lo tanto, nuestra gran custodia redonda de metal es la forma principal en que nuestro Señor Eucarístico se nos muestra para que no solo *podamos ver*, sino *creer* que Él está Verdadera, Real y Sacramentalmente Presente en la Eucaristía (Cf. Jn 20:29).

33. Cuando adoramos a nuestro Señor Eucarístico, "debemos recordar que esta presencia deriva del Sacrificio [de la Misa] y tiende a la comunión sacramental y espiritual". De hecho, al adorar a nuestro Señor, debemos ofrecer oraciones de acción de gracias, alabanza y adoración. Debemos orar por nuestra familia, nuestra parroquia y nuestro mundo. También es loable que leamos la Biblia y nos alimentemos de la Palabra de Dios mientras adoramos la Palabra de Dios, ahora presente en el Sacramento de la Eucaristía.

34. En efecto, para hacer mejores distinciones sobre el tipo de oración que hacemos en presencia del Santísimo Sacramento, es necesario definir dos términos: (1) adoración y (2) exposición.

35. *La adoración* es definida en el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica como "el primer acto de la virtud de la religión. Adorar a Dios es reconocerlo como Dios, como Creador y Salvador, Señor y Amo de todo lo que existe, como Amor infinito y misericordioso. 'Adorarás al Señor tu Dios, y a él solo servirás', dice Jesús, citando el Deuteronomio. Cuando adoramos a Dios, lo estamos reconociendo como nuestro Señor, reconociendo su divinidad omnipotente frente a nuestra propia humanidad limitada. Podemos hacer actos de adoración aparte de las visitas al Santísimo Sacramento (como en los momentos de oración privada). Sin embargo, cuando estamos en la presencia del Señor en el Santísimo Sacramento, solemnemente reservado en el tabernáculo, también podemos adorar el sagrado Cuerpo de nuestro Señor Eucarístico, que está sacramentalmente presente en medio de nosotros. Esto es adoración.

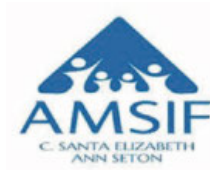
Wednesday Morning English Bible Study

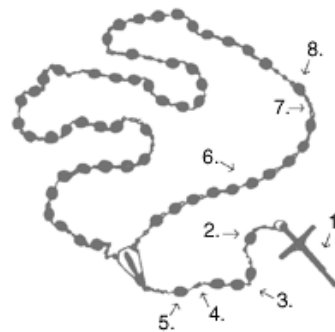

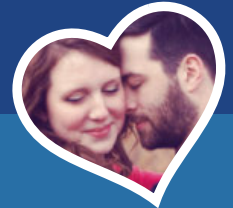

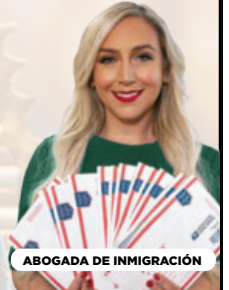
