

Pastor's Message

"Over the next few weeks, the bulletin will present portions of a Pastoral Letter written by Fr. Earthman, entitled O Sacrum Convivium / O Sacred Banquet."

36. Exposition is the liturgical rite whereby the Blessed Sacrament is exposed in a monstrance (or a ciborium) and placed upon an altar or carried in procession. The rite of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is regulated by the Church's liturgical books, which specifies the way in which this rite occurs. Recently, the Holy See has published an updated liturgical book that regulates the rites of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Although this updated book has only been published in English, its rules governing Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament are normative for the United States, regardless of the language that is being used. Here at the parish of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, the norms present in this book will be concretely implemented below. It is enough to state that, during Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, that Adoration occurs. However, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament does not require the liturgical rite of Exposition, as any Christian may offer prayers of adoration to our Eucharistic Lord, even present in the tabernacle.

37. This distinction is necessary to understand the times when Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament can occur even apart from Solemn Exposition. Indeed, Holy Hours can take place in the Church, whereby groups of the Faithful gather to pray in the presence of Christ, present in the tabernacle. There they can offer prayers and songs, pray in silence, or even read from Sacred Scripture. Indeed, Christ does not abandon his Presence from us when we gather around him in the tabernacle. He still calls us to himself. He still calls us to holiness. He still calls us to adore him, present in the Blessed Sacrament.

The Distribution of Holy Communion to the Sick, the Homebound, and the Dying

38. Since antiquity, Christians have been reserving the Holy Eucharist in order that it might be brought to the sick and dying. Indeed, those who were unable to be present at the weekly celebration of the Eucharist due to sickness or grave illness were given a portion of the Body of the Lord consecrated at that Mass. Thus, the Unity of Christ's Body that was forged in the reception of Holy Communion by the Faithful at Sunday Mass was further extended and reinforced by the reception of Holy Communion by the sick and homebound. Christ's Body is strengthened when her members are nourished by the Eucharist. Indeed, those who receive Holy Communion outside Mass are

intimately united with the Sacrifice which perpetuates the Sacrifice of the Cross, and they are participants in that sacred banquet in which, "by Communion in the Body and Blood of the Lord, the People of God participates in the blessings of the Paschal Sacrifice, renews the New Covenant made once by God with men in the Blood of Christ, and in faith and hope prefigures and anticipates the eschatological banquet of the Kingdom of the Father, proclaiming the Death of the Lord until he comes."

Mensaje del Párroco

36. La exposición es el rito litúrgico mediante el cual el Santísimo Sacramento se expone en una custodia (o copón) y se coloca sobre un altar o se lleva en procesión. El rito de la Exposición del Santísimo Sacramento está regulado por los libros litúrgicos de la Iglesia, que especifican la forma en que se produce este rito. Recientemente, la Santa Sede ha publicado un libro litúrgico actualizado que regula los ritos de exposición del Santísimo Sacramento. Aunque este libro actualizado solo se ha publicado en inglés, sus reglas que rigen la Exposición del Santísimo Sacramento son normativas para los Estados Unidos, independientemente del idioma que se utilice. Aquí, en la parroquia de St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, las normas presentes en este libro se implementarán concretamente a continuación. Baste decir que, durante la Exposición del Santísimo Sacramento, se produce la Adoración. Sin embargo, la Adoración del Santísimo Sacramento no requiere el rito litúrgico de Exposición, ya que cualquier cristiano puede ofrecer oraciones de adoración a nuestro Señor Eucarístico, incluso presente en el tabernáculo.

37. Esta distinción es necesaria para comprender los momentos en que la adoración del Santísimo Sacramento puede tener lugar incluso fuera de la exposición solemne. De hecho, en la Iglesia pueden tener lugar las Horas Santas, en las que grupos de fieles se reúnen para orar en presencia de Cristo, presente en el tabernáculo. Allí pueden ofrecer oraciones y cantos, rezar en silencio o incluso leer las Sagradas Escrituras. De hecho, Cristo no abandona su presencia de nosotros cuando nos reunimos a su alrededor en el tabernáculo. Todavía nos llama a sí mismo. Todavía nos llama a la santidad. Todavía nos llama a adorarlo, presente en el Santísimo Sacramento.

La distribución de la Sagrada Comunión a los enfermos, a los confinados en sus hogares y a los moribundos

38. Desde la antigüedad, los cristianos reservan la sagrada Eucaristía para llevarla a los enfermos y moribundos. De hecho, a aquellos que no podían estar presentes en la celebración semanal de la Eucaristía debido a enfermedad o dolencia grave, se les daba una porción del Cuerpo del Señor consagrado en esa Misa. Por lo tanto, la Unidad del Cuerpo de Cristo que se forjó en la recepción de la Sagrada Comunión por parte de los Fieles en la Misa dominical se extendió y reforzó aún más con la recepción de la Sagrada Comunión por parte de los enfermos y confinados en casa. El Cuerpo de Cristo se fortalece cuando sus miembros son alimentados por la Eucaristía. De hecho, los que reciben la Sagrada Comunión fuera de la Misa son

íntimamente unidos al Sacrificio que perpetúa el Sacrificio de la Cruz, y son partícipes de aquel sagrado banquete en el que, "por la Comunión en el Cuerpo y en la Sangre del Señor, el Pueblo de Dios participa de las bendiciones del Sacrificio Pascual, renueva la Nueva Alianza hecha una vez por Dios con los hombres en la Sangre de Cristo, y en la fe y en la esperanza prefigura y anticipa el banquete escatológico del Reino del Padre, proclamando la muerte del Señor hasta que él venga".






