



Pastor's Message

Lent 4 – 30 March 2025

The Catechumens are Baptized into the Faith of the Church
(The Handing Over of the Apostle's Creed)

At one point during the final few weeks of Lent, those who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil will be ritually “given” the Apostles Creed as part of their pre-baptismal preparation rites. Unbaptized persons are referred to as Catechumens, though during the final six weeks before Easter are called “the Elect,” as they are chosen (or elected) by God to be received into his Kingdom through the celebration of the Sacraments of Christian Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Communion). In this late stage of preparation, the Elect are trusted with a precious summary of the Christian life: the Creed.

The Creed – a term coming from the Latin word meaning “I believe” – articulates the Church’s faith in the God of Revelation – the same God who revealed himself in Jesus Christ and by the proclamation of the Gospel by the Apostles in the New Testament. On Sundays and Solemnities, we recite a version of the Creed articulated and synthesized by the Ecumenical Councils of Nicaea I (325 A.D.) and Constantinople I (381 A.D.) On other occasions (such as when we pray the Rosary or the Chaplet of Divine Mercy), we commonly recite a shorter (and likely earlier) version of the Creed known as the Apostles’s Creed. Both Creeds not only succinctly summarize the basics of the Christian Faith, but these Creeds also implicitly include all that the Church teaches and all that she has ever taught, including her dogma, her doctrine, her view of Sacred Scripture, and her Liturgical tradition. To faithfully recite the Creed is to affirm that one “believes and professes all that the holy Catholic Church believes, teaches, and proclaims as revealed by God.” (Cf. *Order of Christian Initiation of Adults* (2024), no. 491). This is why the Creed is sometimes called a “Symbol,” as the Creed itself is a token or a symbolic representation of the entirety of the Christian Faith.

It has been part of pre-baptismal preparation of Catechumens since at least the 6-7th Century to have the Creed “given” to them. As is seen in an 8th Century Roman Sacramentary, an Acolyte would ask a Catechumen’s parent “What language does he speak?”, and depending on the answer, the Acolyte would recite the Creed to the Catechumen in either Latin or Greek. (This is also a great testament that the Church has always existed with multi-lingual communities as an ordinary part of parish life!) The Creed was “given” to the Catechumens aurally, that is, by word of mouth, and by speaking it aloud. The Catechumens would have to listen carefully to receive the Creed, and to memorize it. At some point shortly before Baptism, the Catechumens would be gathered and would have to “give back” the Creed to the clergy, in order to demonstrate that the Creed had been planted deep within the heart of the person to be baptized.

The Latin term for the “giving” of the Creed comes from the term *tradere*, which means “to hand over” or “to hand on”. It is the root of how we speak of the Church’s Sacred Tradition, because these things have been “handed on” to us from the time of the Apostles. Thus, prior to Baptism, the Church “hands over” the Creed to the Elect (the Catechumens), as a sacred gift to be treasured and held dearly. The Faith of the Church is the Faith into which these Elect will be baptized. We are not ever baptized merely by our own personal faith. Rather, we make the Church’s Faith our own.

As we continue to prepare ourselves for the joyful celebrations at Easter in the next few weeks, we should continue to pray for the Elect, for their ongoing conversion to the Lord, for our own conversion and repentance, so that the Faith of the Church – as summarized by the Creed we recite each Sunday – can take root deeper and deeper into our own hearts as well.

Mensaje del Párroco

Cuaresma 4 – 30 de Marzo del 2025

Los Catecúmenos son Bautizados en la Fe de la Iglesia
(Entrega del Credo de los Apóstoles)

Durante las últimas semanas de Cuaresma, quienes serán bautizados en la Vigilia Pascual recibirán ritualmente el Credo de los Apóstoles como parte de sus ritos de preparación prebautismal. A las personas no bautizadas se les llama Catecúmenos, aunque durante las últimas seis semanas antes de la Pascua se les llama "los Elegidos", ya que son elegidos por Dios para ser recibidos en su Reino mediante la celebración de los Sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana (Bautismo, Confirmación, Sagrada Comunión). En esta última etapa de la preparación, a los Elegidos se les confía un valioso resumen de la vida Cristiana: el Credo.

El Credo, término que proviene del Latín y significa "Creo", articula la fe de la Iglesia en el Dios de la Revelación, el mismo Dios que se reveló en Jesucristo y mediante la proclamación del Evangelio por los Apóstoles en el Nuevo Testamento. Los Domingos y Solemnidades, recitamos una versión del Credo articulada y sintetizada por los Concilios Ecuménicos de Nicea I (325 D. C.) y Constantinopla I (381 D. C.). En otras ocasiones (como al rezar el Rosario o la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia), solemos recitar una versión más corta (y probablemente anterior) del Credo, conocida como el Credo de los Apóstoles. Ambos Credos no solo resumen sucintamente los fundamentos de la Fe Cristiana, sino que también incluyen implícitamente todo lo que la Iglesia enseña y ha enseñado, incluyendo su dogma, su doctrina, su visión de la Sagrada Escritura y su tradición Litúrgica. Recitar fielmente el Credo es afirmar que uno «cree y profesa todo lo que la santa Iglesia Católica cree, enseña y proclama como revelado por Dios» (Cf. Orden de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos (2024), n.º 491). Por eso, el Credo a veces se denomina "Símbolo", ya que es una muestra o representación simbólica de la totalidad de la Fe Cristiana.

Recibir el Credo ha formado parte de la preparación prebautismal de los Catecúmenos desde al menos los Siglos VI-VII. Como se observa en un Sacramentario Romano del siglo VIII, un Acólito preguntaba a los padres del Catecúmeno: «¿Qué idioma habla?», y, según la respuesta, el Acólito recitaba el Credo al Catecúmeno en Latín o en Griego. (¡Esto también es un gran testimonio de que la Iglesia siempre ha contado con comunidades multilingües como parte de la vida parroquial!). El Credo se les daba a los Catecúmenos de forma oral, es decir, de boca en boca y en voz alta. Los Catecúmenos debían escuchar atentamente para recibir el Credo y memorizarlo. Poco antes del Bautismo, los catecúmenos se reunían y debían "devolver" El Credo al clero para demostrar que había sido arraigado en el corazón de la persona que iba a ser bautizada.

En Latín el término para "dar" el Credo proviene de *tradere*, que significa "entregar" o "transmitir". Es la raíz de cómo hablamos de la Sagrada Tradición de la Iglesia, porque nos ha sido transmitida desde los tiempos de los Apóstoles. Así, antes del Bautismo, la Iglesia entrega el Credo a los Elegidos (los Catecúmenos), como un don sagrado que deben atesorar y conservar con cariño. La Fe de la Iglesia es la Fe en la que estos Elegidos serán bautizados. Nunca nos bautizamos simplemente por nuestra fe personal. Más bien, hacemos nuestra la Fe de la Iglesia.

Mientras nos preparamos para las alegres celebraciones de Pascua en las próximas semanas, debemos seguir orando por los Elegidos, por su continua conversión al Señor, por nuestra propia conversión y arrepentimiento, para que la Fe de la Iglesia —resumen en el Credo que recitamos cada Domingo— se arraigue cada vez más en nuestros corazones.


