



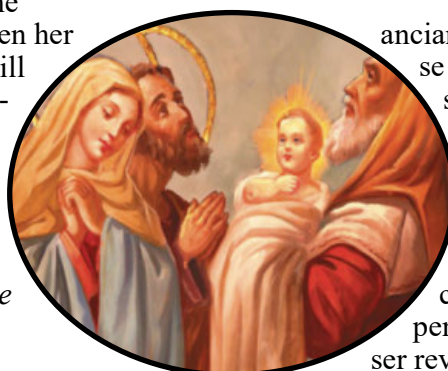

MARY'S PIERCED HEART.

Mary teaches us this in the prophecy of her pierced heart. This Sunday, the old man Simeon prophesies that when her son faces opposition, Mary's soul will be pierced by a sword. The seemingly pointless agony of a mother helplessly watching her son be mocked, tortured, killed and then cruelly desecrated in death by a spear; somehow this piercing of her heart releases a power by which *"the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed"* (Luke 2:35).

Whatever problems we currently face, the deepest threat is finally that evil thoughts are hidden in the human heart: hatred, envy, pride, lust, greed and so on. Behind every tyrant's injustice, for example, is a heart unpierced by love. Evil hides in our hearts. Mary's pierced heart, and its suffering love for her son, reveals and scatters these evil thoughts, and replaces them with love, forgiveness, generosity and peace.

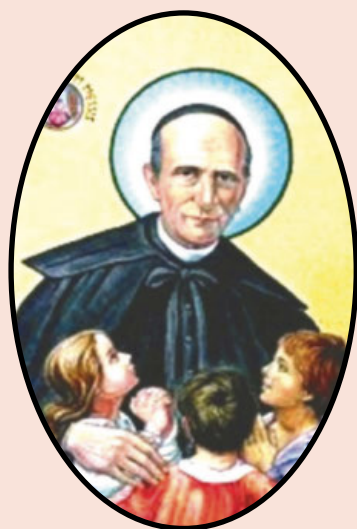

The Presentation of the Lord

EL CORAZÓN TRASPASADO DE MARÍA.

María nos enseña esto en la profecía de su corazón traspasado. Este domingo, el anciano Simeón profetiza que cuando su hijo se enfrente a la oposición, el alma de María será traspasada por una espada. La agonía aparentemente inútil de una madre que ve impotente cómo su hijo es burlado, torturado, asesinado y luego cruelmente profanado en la muerte por una lanza: de alguna manera, esta perforación de su corazón libera un poder por el cual "los pensamientos de muchos corazones pueden ser revelados" (Lucas 2:35).

Cualquier problema que enfrentamos actualmente, la amenaza más profunda es finalmente que los malos pensamientos están ocultos en el corazón humano: odio, envidia, orgullo, lujuria, avaricia, etc. Detrás de la injusticia de cada tirano, por ejemplo, hay un corazón no traspasado por el amor. El mal se esconde en nuestros corazones. El corazón traspasado de María, y el sufrimiento por su hijo, revela y dispersa estos malos pensamientos, y los reemplaza con amor, perdón, generosidad y paz.

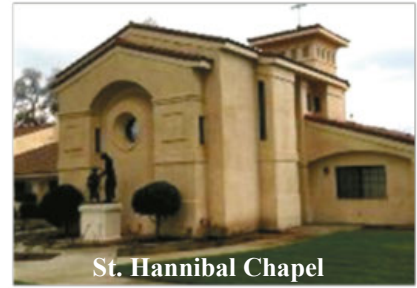

Monday: St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr; believe martyred in the persecution of Licinius, early 4th c.; bishop of Sebaste in Armenia; associated with the healing of throats.



St. Ansgar, Bishop; + 865 at Bremen; O.S.B. missionary to Denmark and Sweden; bishop of Hamburg; great preacher and administrator; known as the "Apostle of the North" Patron of Denmark, Germany and Iceland.



Wednesday: St. Agatha, Virgin and Martyr; Agatha, + probably under Decius in Sicily; patroness of Palermo and Catania; invoked for protection against volcanic eruptions and fires; mentioned in the Roman Canon.



Thursday: St. Paul Miki and Companions, Martyrs; Paul Miki,

Jesuit scholastic, and his twenty-five companions, including two other Jesuits, six Franciscans, fifteen tertiaries, and two laymen, were crucified by order of the ruler Hideyoshi 5 Feb. 1597 at Nagasaki; among them the Mexican, Felipe de Jesus, first martyr from the Americas to be beatified; proto-martyrs of the Far East.

CARTA ABIERTA DEL OBISPO BRENNAN EN RESPUESTA A LOS PROBLEMAS MIGRATORIOS DEL VALLE CENTRAL

14 de enero de 2025

Escrito por: el Reverendísimo Joseph V. Brennan D.D., Obispo de la Diócesis de Fresno

Hace poco más de un mes que los Cristianos Católicos celebramos un día de fiesta muy importante dentro de nuestra comunidad latina y específicamente la Mexicana, la Fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. En este día todos los Obispos Católicos Romanos aquí en el Estado de California, incluido yo, emitimos una breve declaración titulada, ¿No estoy yo aquí, que soy tu madre? Ese título se atribuye a las palabras pronunciadas por Nuestra Señora a Juan Diego, el otro personaje clave en el evento de Guadalupe, quien necesitaba Consuelo mientras lidiaba con sus propias dudas y temores. Nuestra declaración fue dirigida a algunos de nuestros hermanos y hermanas de hoy, que también tienen que hacer frente a muchos miedos como consecuencia de su situación migratoria. También fue dirigida a aquellos que podrían ser la causa de tal miedo, por no mencionar a otros que podrían hacer algo al respecto.

Nuestra declaración fue emitida en el momento más oportuno y habla proféticamente sobre los desafíos que pueden surgir y que aún no están claros. Parece que algunos de esos desafíos, se han hecho demasiado claros ahora, especialmente teniendo en cuenta lo que ha sucedido recientemente en y alrededor del Condado de Kern y en otras áreas de nuestro Valle Central. La Patrulla Fronteriza ha estado presente y activa en nuestro Valle. Yo mismo los vi, patrullando a lo largo del corredor 99, en varios de nuestros vecindarios, en nuestros campos de cosecha y afuera de lugares de negocios. Parecía como si hubiéramos dado un paso atrás como sociedad, y los viejos tiempos de las redadas de inmigración estuvieran de nuevo sobre nosotros. A nuestra gente se le pide que presente prueba de ciudadanía, y parece como si la solicitud se basara en su aspecto y su forma de hablar. No se trata, por ejemplo, de perseguir a criminales empedernidos o traficantes de drogas, a lo que espero, ninguno de nosotros se opondría. Están persiguiendo a personas a las que, con razón o sin ella, se les permitió cruzar una frontera y que ahora están siendo sometidas a tácticas que están causando mucho miedo y ansiedad entre mi gente. Es un insulto a la dignidad humana, y simplemente está mal.

Yo, y mis compañeros obispos junto con otros socios de la comunidad aquí en el Valle Central, seguiremos sirviendo como recursos de confianza para aquellos que necesitan ayuda o que simplemente necesitan que se les respondan algunas preguntas en estos tiempos difíciles y peligrosos para algunos. De hecho, se puede encontrar una lista preliminar de recursos en el sitio www.cacatholic.org/immigration.

Permítanme concluir con otra cita del documento de nuestros obispos que, aunque dirigida a nuestras parroquias y a la comunidad católica, realmente aplica y nos interpela a todos:

No se puede permitir que continúe el desorden en nuestra frontera. Rezamos con ustedes para que cualquier política promulgada restablezcan el sentido de seguridad y paz para los ciudadanos, así como para aquellos que buscan encontrar un hogar en esta bendita tierra. Para lograr ese fin, las políticas deben reflejar empatía y solicitud, con la debida consideración a los derechos de los niños y de quienes huyen de países violentos y empobrecidos, sin dejar de dar tregua a los delincuentes graves.

Creo que esto es algo en lo que todos podemos estar de acuerdo y por lo que todos podemos trabajar.

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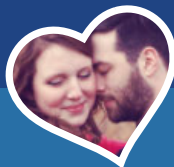

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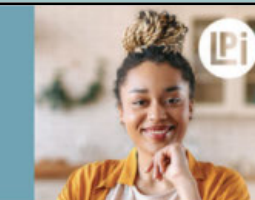
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
