Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This upcoming Saturday, May 27th, our Deacon Binh Ha will be ordained to the priesthood by Bishop Michael Barber. The ordination will take place at 11 am at the Cathedral of Christ the Light in Oakland. Everyone is very welcome to attend. He will celebrate his first Mass as a priest here at St. Isidore's at 4 pm the same day. Please keep him in your prayers as he prepares for ordination.

Many of us priests in the Diocese of Oakland were ordained around this time. Witnessing the grace of ordination to the priesthood reminds me of my own six years ago. I remember the day of my ordination well. A few days prior I was invited to have dinner with the Bishop, in keeping with a custom he continues to this day. At that dinner, as he does with all ordinands, the Bishop gives them a small purple and white stole typically used for visits to the sick or other "surprise" opportunities to celebrate the sacraments. I used that same stole to give blessings on the day of ordination. I still have it to this day. It reminds me that I am always a priest, consecrated for the service of God and the people He loves so much. It is a constant invitation to love with the Heart of the Good Shephard at every moment.

My ordination anniversary is May 26. Fr. Candelario's is May 22. Toss up a prayer for us, that we be holy. That's all we really need.

On another note, parishes in our Diocese will begin distributing the Precious Blood at Mass. In the next few weeks, we will resume the practice of receiving from the chalice here in our parish when our ministers are again properly trained to prepare for it.





7th Sunday of Easter Meditation

Traditionally, the four writers of the Gospels are symbolized by four creatures that make their way into Church art and architecture: Matthew, an angel; Mark, a lion; Luke, an ox; and John, an eagle. These images can be found in churches across the world, a nod to those who recorded the stories of Jesus for us, thousands of years ago.

Today's Gospel was written by John. There are a few reasons why John is symbolized by an eagle, but my favorite explanation is that his writings soar like an eagle into the sky with their beautiful, poetic language. The prayer we hear today is no different — Jesus invokes God in a long discourse that might seem mystifying at times, the same way that a poem can be perplexing to understand when we are unfamiliar with the pacing or format.

Consider holding onto the shortest sentence in this prayer: "I pray for them."

Jesus prays for us. For me. For you.

Let that sink deep into your being.

Jesus is on your side. He is aware of what you are holding at this moment. He is aware of your pain, your faith, your mission. And He's rooting for you. This prayer was recorded thousands of years ago, far before you were born. Since before you were born, you were held in prayer. With that certainty, we live.


