

"Go and learn what this means, 'I desire mercy, not sacrifice.' For I have come to call not the righteous but sinners." Matthew 9:13

Mercy Sunday, also known as **Divine Mercy Sunday**, is an important feast in our Catholic Church, celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. It was officially established by Pope John Paul II in the year 2000, coinciding with the canonization of Saint Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, who received visions and messages from Jesus Christ about His divine mercy.

The origins of Divine Mercy Sunday stem from Saint Faustina's diary, **Divine Mercy in My Soul**, where she recorded her mystical encounters with Christ. According to her writings, Jesus emphasized His boundless mercy for sinners and requested that a feast be established to encourage devotion to His divine mercy. He specifically asked that this feast be observed on the Sunday after Easter and promised great graces to those who sincerely seek His mercy.

One of the central aspects of Divine Mercy Sunday is the Divine Mercy image, which depicts Jesus with two rays emanating from His heart—one red (symbolizing His blood) and one pale (representing water, baptism, and the Holy Spirit). The image bears the inscription "Jesus, I trust in You", highlighting the core message of the devotion: complete trust in God's mercy.

The Church grants a plenary indulgence to those who, on Divine Mercy Sunday, partake in the Sacrament of Confession (before or on the day), receive the Eucharist, and pray for the intentions of the Pope. Additionally, Catholics are encouraged to practice acts of mercy through deeds, words, or prayers, reflecting Christ's love and compassion.

Divine Mercy Sunday also promotes the recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet, a prayer revealed to Saint Faustina that invokes God's mercy on the world. Many parishes hold special Divine Mercy services, including the Chaplet, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, and reflections on God's mercy.

Overall, Divine Mercy Sunday is a celebration of God's infinite love and forgiveness, inviting all people to trust in His mercy and extend it to others. It serves as a reminder that no sin is too great for God's forgiveness, encouraging a renewal of faith and devotion in the Risen Christ.

At Saint Charles, The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be prayed after the 11:30 AM Holy Mass. All are invited to participate in this great devotion.


