Ministry CORNER

April 21th

Easter season is still here! Alleluia! Christ is Risen! Alleluia!

I can't help but think and then ask what can we do to help someone who is in need as a regular part of our lives? What can we do as members of the parish on a regular basis? Is there a cause we can start or continue? There are so many needs in this world, it's hard to know where to start. Many of us have tried so many things and sometimes it seems as if there is nothing, we can do to make things better for someone else.

Once again ministry means 'SERVICE TO OTHERS.' Does it always mean helping the needy? What happens if you step out of your box and look for a need that isn't as obvious as others? It would be so worthwhile if someone responded to my questions on service and gave us new ideas. It's easy to help grandma mow her lawn but not as easy to help her pull weeds and plant some wildflower seeds. It's easy to give a neighbor a meal but not as easy to ask what their favorites are and prepare something they like. It's easy to be a Eucharistic Minister at 10:30 Mass, but not as easy to be one at 7:15. This list can go and on.

Truthfully, I don't know the complete answer. I do know that there are needs everywhere, but where do we start? Or is it easier to turn our backs and "let be what will be!" A few weeks ago, I spoke about my personal project in attempting to get a couple of polite, nice children into the school. I did what I could to help them. They were accepted and that was when the miracle occurred. The cost of catholic school education is expensive – more so than when my children were attending. Someone over this weekend emailed me and asked if he could receive more information. He wanted to help. I would have been happy if 100 parishioners had offered me \$5. I would have been happy if a parishioner / school parent had offered me a used uniform in excellent shape. I would have been happy if someone had come to see me with any kind of suggestion. But this parishioner had inherited some money, and he was willing to share it. This was certainly thinking out of the box.

I was talking to Kathy Sturgeon this week about the Gabriel Project. She has been taking care of about 100 mothers a week. Many are those that return for diapers and formula. She gave away 6 car seats a few weeks ago. Official – approved car seats are expensive. But we are fortunate that we have a group who are interested in helping these young mothers. They are our unsung heroes! If you are looking for a simple way to help – diapers are the answer! She needs sizes 4-5-6-7. Check online for a website called Everylife. It is a pro-life diaper company. If you order diapers from there our own Gabriel Project can receive some credit for the group to use. We will be planning a drive-through in the early summer where you drop off diapers or whatever else they need. YLI will be hosting a baby shower in May. Again, think outside the box. Babies and mothers need a lot of items that are now more expensive than ever.

My challenge to all of us (including me) is to think outside of the box. If you find yourself helping someone in a difficult situation or even in a normal situation, you will be provided a service that might never be used.



CROWNING OF FLOWERS


