PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

It is comforting to know that my message from the "Pastor's Corner" has been well received by many. So with encouragement, I continue to write.

Last Sunday, I was planning to write about what we might miss when we leave before the Concluding Rites, but I did not get to it because there was too much to share about the Prayer after Communion and Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel. So this Sunday, let us try to understand this part of the Mass which is sadly missed by many people. As I mentioned last Sunday, the Concluding Rites have three parts: Optional Announcements; Greeting and Blessing; and Dismissal.

As soon as the Prayer after Communion ends and the congregation sits down for announcements, many people head out to the doors, thinking that Mass has ended. The first thing they miss are the announcements. As we all know, our parish is a very vibrant community. There are announcements to let us know about many things going on in the parish and the diocese, like religious education, coffee and donuts, blessing of the animals, festival, holy days of obligation, etc. Just a few days ago, a parishioner showed me an "I Am" prayer card and told me, "Father, this is a great event in the diocese, but how come our church doesn't have it and doesn't say anything about it?" I am appalled how he could miss that announcement which we had almost every week. This is just an example of many important announcements which we would like you to know. We do not make announcements to waste your precious time, but they are made for your own spiritual benefit.

After the announcements, there is another dialogue between the priest and the congregation, "The Lord be with you. And with your spirit." This dialogue is the fourth and final one of the Mass to remind us that God is with us as we are about to leave church to go into the world, and it ensures us that God is always with us. We should be encouraged and have no fear.

After the dialogue comes the final blessing, in which the Church calls upon the triune God to bestow on us happiness and sanctification that we may go forth from the Mass renewed in zeal for our mission and strengthened to resist evil and grow in the spiritual life. It is sad to see many people walking away from God's grace.

At the end of Mass, we hear the words of dismissal, "Go forth, the Mass is ended." I like the Latin verse better, "*Ite, missa est.*" Literally it means, "Go, she—the Church—has been sent." We are part of the Church, and we are sent on a mission. The USCCB's website explains that, "The word '*Missa*' is related to the word '*missio*,' the root of the English word 'mission.' The liturgy does not simply come to an end. Those assembled are sent forth to bring the fruits of the Eucharist to the world."

It is always delightful to see you in church, but since you have already made the effort to celebrate Mass, let us be there from the beginning till the end to be fully blessed with God's grace.





CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XXVI MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN NĂM A

Mt 21, 28-32 "Nó hồi hận và đi làm. Những người thu thuế và gái điếm sẽ vào nước Thiên Chúa trước các ông".

Thật là một điều khích lệ đáng quý khi biết được nhiều giáo dân theo dõi mục "Pastor's Corner" được đăng hàng tuần trên bản thông tin của giáo xứ. Hiểu theo tiếng Việt, đây là góc tâm tình của linh mục chánh xứ gửi đến giáo dân về những sinh hoạt và sự việc đang xảy ra trong giáo xứ.

Tuần trước tôi dự trù viết về những ân sủng mà nhiều người đã vô tình bỏ qua khi ra về trước Nghi Thức Kết Lễ. Dự trù như thế, nhưng chưa sao thực hiện được vì cần phải trình bày về Lời Nguyện Hiệp Lễ và kinh Cầu Cùng Tổng Lãnh Thiên Thần Micae. Vậy tuần này tôi sẽ viết về Nghi Thức Kết Lễ. Nghi thức này có ba phần: Thông báo (không bắt buộc); Lời chào và phép lành; và Giải tán.

Ngay sau Lời Nguyện Hiệp Lễ, mọi người đang chuẩn bị ngồi xuống để nghe thông báo thì nhiều người vội bỏ ra về, cho rằng Lễ đã xong và chẳng còn gì để ở lại. Những người này đã vô tình bỏ qua những thông tin cần thiết trong cộng đoàn, giáo xứ, và giáo phận. Như mọi người biết, giáo xứ chúng ta là một cộng đồng rất sinh động, gồm nhiều sinh hoạt diễn ra hàng ngày và hàng tuần, chẳng hạn như giáo lý, Việt ngữ, Thiếu Nhi Thánh Thể, Tết Trung Thu, hội chợ, Châu Thánh Thể, Đại Hội Thánh Thể, vv. Chúng tôi không thông báo để làm mất thời giờ của quý vị, nhưng để quý vị biết được những lợi ích quý vị đáng lãnh nhận.

Sau phần thông báo là lời chào đối thoại giữa linh mục chủ tế chào giáo dân: "Chúa ở cùng anh chị em." Giáo dân thưa, "Và ở cùng Cha." Đây là lần thứ tư và cũng là lần cuối trong Thánh Lễ trước khi chúng ta ra đi vào thế gian. Lời chào này nhắc nhở rằng Thiên Chúa hằng ở cùng chúng ta trong sứ vụ của mình. Chúng ta hãy can đảm lên và không có gì phải sợ hãi.

Tiếp đến là phép lành cuối lễ. Trong phép lành này, Giáo Hội kêu xin Thiên Chúa Ba Ngôi ban cho anh chị em được thánh hóa, tràn đầy hạnh phúc, và nghị lực, để chống trả lại mưu chước của ma quỷ, chu toàn sứ vụ làm chứng tá cho Chúa, và lớn lên trong sự thánh thiện. Điều đáng tiếc là nhiều người đã bỏ qua ân sủng cao quý này của Thiên Chúa.

Cuối cùng là lời chào sai đi, "Lễ xong, chúc anh chị em đi bằng an." Tôi thích bản văn bằng tiếng La Tinh hơn, "Ite, missa est." vì chữ "missa" còn mang ý nghĩa là "sứ vụ." Lời chào này không chỉ kết thúc việc cử hành phụng vụ, nhưng còn sai chúng ta mang theo những ân phúc của phép Thánh Thể vào thế gian.

Khi thấy đông đảo quý ông bà anh chị em đi Lễ mỗi tuần, tôi rất vui mừng. Hy vọng khi đã đến nhà thờ rồi, chúng ta cố gắng cử hành Thánh Lễ từ đầu tới cuối, để chúng ta có thể lãnh ân sủng Chúa cách trọn vẹn.


